

Indoor Play— The children can choose different learning experiences, such as block play, dramatic play, craft, puzzles, playdough, painting, drawing, matching games, reading books and construction.



Group times— These are small and large groups where we sing songs, listen to stories and have discussions. The children take turns to do our days of the week and weather chart. These groups prompt a love of books and develop literacy skills and are based on the children's interests.

Music time— We sing, move to music, play musical instruments and explore music concepts such as beat and rhythm.



What happens in a day at Preschool?

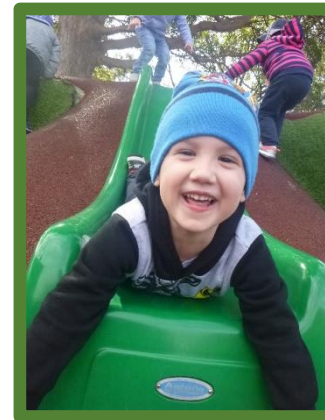


Quiet Time— Each day after lunch the children have opportunities to rest, read stories and do quiet activities.



Meal times— The children bring their own morning tea and lunch which they eat while sitting with their classmates.

Bible Time— each week we share a Bible story with the children and they enjoy doing a craft relating to the story. Throughout the week we also sing Christian based songs, read other stories and say Grace before meals.



Outdoor play— The children chose from different experiences including sand play, climbing, ball games, playing with our pet rabbits and chickens, collecting the chicken eggs, caring for our vegetable garden, construction play, painting, water play and cooking in the bush kitchen.
