  - Smoke detectors, heat detectors, duct smoke detectors, relay modules, control modules, monitor modules, power supplies, audio & visual output devices
- Plan and initiate projects.
- Lay out, install and verify operation of fire alarm systems.
- Meet all installation deadlines.
- Responsible for accurate tracking on time sheets, installation tickets, and inventory items.

- Other duties as required or assigned by company management.
