

## Jeremiah 7, 25, 31, 36 & Ezekiel 7, 15 & 37 - Jeremiah and Ezekiel

Jeremiah and Ezekiel are two prophets who ministered to the people of Jerusalem and to the exiles in Babylon; their oracles were written down and became books of the Bible.

1. Read **Jeremiah 7:1-20** for a sample of Jeremiah's harsh words against the people and their temple. Note their two sins:
