

Luke 17:1-17 - A Centurion's Servant & a Crying Widow

1. First, let's consider the centurion. Read **Luke 7:1-10**. What kind of man was the centurion?
2. On what basis did the Jewish elders ask for Jesus' help?
3. How is this different from the way the centurion approached Jesus?
4. Do you think Jesus made a good decision in healing the servant? What if the centurion had not been such a 'good guy'? Should Jesus still have honored his request?
5. Now let's consider the widow. Read **Luke 7:11-17**. How would you have reacted to the crying widow?
6. How did the crowd react after the healing?
7. If you had been in the crowd, what would you have thought of Jesus?

8. Jesus healed people in both of these stories by the power of his **WORD**. Do you think Jesus' word still has that kind of power today? Can you name an example in your own life?
