

## Luke 24 - Jesus' Resurrection

1. Skim through **Luke 24:1-53** to show who spoke these words and to whom they were spoken.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Why are you looking among the dead for one who is alive?

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Remember what he told you while in Galilee.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ What are you discussing with each other?

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Are you a stranger in Jerusalem?

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus of Nazareth was a prophet, mighty in deed and in word.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ We had hoped he would redeem Israel.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Some of our women astonished us.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Was it not necessary for the Messiah to suffer these things and then to enter into his glory?

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Stay with us; the day is almost over.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ The Lord is risen indeed!

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Peace be with you.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ A ghost does not have flesh and bones as I have.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ What do you have to eat?

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Everything written about me in the law, the prophets, and the psalms had to come true.

\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ You are witnesses to these things.

2. Go back and re-read **Luke 24:1-12**. Who were the first people at the tomb that Sunday morning? Why had they gone there? What did they see? What did they do?

3. According to **Luke 24:11**, the disciples didn't believe what the women told them. Why do you suppose they reacted that way? How would you have reacted?

4. Now re-read **Luke 24:13-27**. What were Cleopas and his friend (maybe his wife?) talking about as they walked along?
  
5. How did Jesus (whom they didn't recognize!) respond?
  
6. According to **Luke 24:28-35**, when did they recognize him? What does this remind you of?
  
7. **Luke 24:36-43** tells how the eleven disciples reacted when Jesus appeared to them. How did he demonstrate that it was really himself, not a ghost?
  
8. What promise did Jesus make to his disciples, according to **Luke 24:44-49**?
  
9. Finally, read **Luke 24:50-53**. How and where did Jesus say farewell? And how did his disciples react?
