## Luke 13 – Jesus and a Bent Woman

1. For background, read **Exodus 20:8-11** and **Leviticus 23:3**. What is so special about the Sabbath Day? And what are its requirements?

2. Now read Luke 13:10-17. Why was the man in charge of the meeting place so upset with Jesus' healing?

3. What was Jesus' response?

4. Notice in **verse 16** that Jesus refers to the woman as "a daughter of Abraham." This is an unusual title; usually it's "a son of Abraham." What does this suggest about how Jesus values women?

5. The Sabbath Day is the seventh day of the week, Saturday. Do you observe Saturday as a day of rest? Or has our Sunday, the first day of the week, replaced the Sabbath? And if so, what if anything is different?
