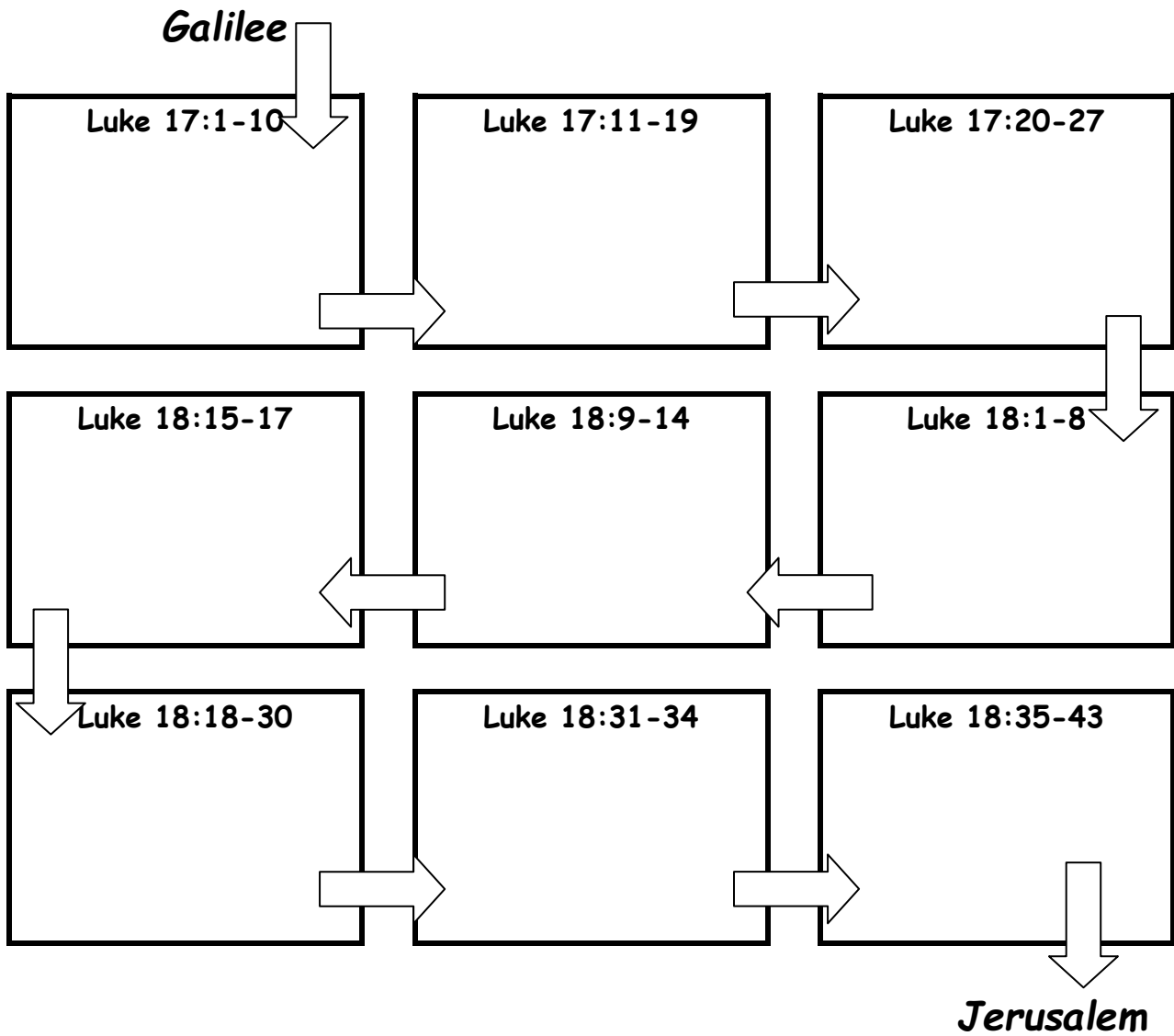


## Luke 17-18 - Jesus' Trip to Jerusalem
