

Luke 20-21 - Jesus' Teachings in the Temple

1. During the last week of his life Jesus spent much of his time in the temple. He argued with his opponents, taught the people, and encouraged his disciples. Number these teachings of Jesus in order according to **Luke 20:1-21:38**.

- Everyone will hate you because of me.
- Be on your guard against the teachers of the law...who take advantage of widows...then make long prayers.
- Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
- Neither will I tell you, then, by what right I do these things.
- He is the God of the living, not of the dead, for to him all are alive.
- This poor widow put in more than all the others.
- The Son of Man will appear, coming in a cloud with great power and glory.
- Pay to the Emperor what belongs to the Emperor, and pay to God what belongs to God.
- Don't be afraid when you hear of wars and revolutions.
- Terrible distress will come upon this land.
- Everyone who falls on that stone will be cut to pieces.
- Be on watch and pray always that you will have the strength to go safely through.
- The time will come when not a single stone here will be left in its place; every one will be thrown down.
- How can it be said that the Messiah will be the descendant of King David?
