 - _____ Pilate sends Jesus to King Herod.
 - _____ The leaders insult Jesus: "Let him save himself if he really is the Messiah."
 - _____ The women from Galilee watch where Jesus is buried.
 - _____ A sign hung over Jesus' head says, "This is the King of the Jews."
 - _____ For the third time, Pilate insists Jesus has done nothing wrong.
