FACILITY

A 50-meter, 8-lane competition pool with movable bulkheads. This pool was used in the 2008 Olympic trials in Omaha, Nebraska. Twenty one American records and nine world records were set in this pool! At 7'7" and 79 degrees, this spectacular competition pool is the only 50-meter pool in Central Virginia and one of the finest along the East Coast! Colorado Timing System will be used in conjunction with Hy-Tek Meet Management software.

CHAMPIONSHIP MEET FORMAT

All swimmers and relays will compete in the morning preliminaries. Finals will consist of the top 16 swimmers in each event from Prelims. Two heats, slowest to fastest. For placing/scoring purposes, swimmers are locked into their heats.

PRELIMINARIES

Warmups Teams will be assigned times and lanes. Three assigned warm-up sessions, 25 minutes in length each, utilizing both the competition course and the warm-up/cool-down pool. These assignments will be made available by email as of Wednesday, December 13th, and will also be available in your coaches' packet.

Meet 8:00AM start. Two 8 lane, 25 yd courses run simultaneously. Girls on one side, boys on the other

A separate 6 lane, 25 yard training pool will be available for warm-up/cooldown during the preliminaries.

The Meet Director reserves the right to adjust warm-up and start times of the preliminary session as required to best accommodate all entries.

FINALS

General Warmups 4:00-4:50pm All 16 lanes in the championship pool.

Specific Warmups 4:30-4:50 in the competition pool, lanes 1&8 will be designated for pace, and lanes 2&7 will be designated for one way sprints.

Finals 5:00pm
Warm-up/cooldown lanes will be available on the other half of the pool during finals.

Meet Director reserves the right to change the time and arrangement of warm-ups if necessary to make sure the meet stays within the specified timeline.

ENTRIES

DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS SUN, DEC 10th, 5:00PM.

The qualifying period for this meet is Nov. 27, 2016 through Dec. 10, 2017.

Each swimmer may enter and compete in a maximum of FOUR (4) events, no more than two of which may be individual events.

Each team will be permitted a maximum of FOUR (4) entries per individual event. The Meet Director reserves the right to adjust the number of permitted individual entries per event per team, so as to best serve the needs of competing athletes.

The 500 free may be limited to the top 32 boys and top 32 girls (based on meet timeline). Teams will be given the opportunity to move any entries cut to other events, even if this means your team will have more than four entries in that event.

Relay Events. Each team may enter TWO (2) relays per event. These relays must be designated 'A' and 'B' relays. Both the A and B relays in each relay event are eligible to advance to the finals session.

Entries must be submitted in short course yard times. Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager. An events file will be emailed to each team which can be imported into Hy-Tek Team Manager. If the team does not have Team Manager, a free copy of Team Manager Lite may be downloaded from the Hy-Tek web site. This program will allow the team to import the event file and enter swimmers. Teams should submit entries to the Meet Director as an email attachment (**preferred**). Entries must include the swimmer's first name, last name, grade and seed time in yards. **“Relay only” swimmers must be included with the entries.** Only swimmers that are included in your entries may be entered in your relays.

FEES

\$325.00 per school (includes both Boys & Girls teams)

OR

\$30.00 per swimmer (maximum of \$325.00)

DEADLINE

All **payments** need to be **postmarked no later than Thursday, November 30th** unless you have cleared it ahead of time with the Meet Director.

All electronic **entries** or hard entry forms must be received by the Meet Director no later than **Sunday, December 10th, 5:00pm**. Send to George Massey at hswimming1@gmail.com

SEEDING All individual and relay events will be pre-seeded. Swimmers in all preliminary events are to report directly to the starting area as called. Relay cards for the meet will be distributed in the coaches' packets before warm-ups. Coaches are asked to designate the FOUR (4) competitors in the correct order, choosing from the names listed on the Master Entry List, and have the relay swimmers submit the relay card to the lane timers when they report to the blocks for the event.

PENALTIES This meet will be run in a championship format. As such, a competitor officially becomes a participant in an individual event when entries are delivered to the Meet Director by the indicated deadline. A competitor may withdraw from an individual preliminary or final event only with a declared false start. Notice must be given to the Deck Referee before the EVENT is called to the blocks. The event will still count as an entry for the competitor, but it does not disqualify the competitor from further competition.

For relay events, only the four individuals declared on the relay entry card, which shall be submitted directly to the lane timers at the time the event is called to the blocks, shall be permitted to compete in that event. Once the relay card has been delivered to the lane timers, the four competitors listed on the relay card may withdraw from the event only with a declared false start, with notice being given to the Deck Referee before the EVENT is called to the blocks. The event will still count as an entry for the competitors, but it does not disqualify them from further competition.

A SCRATCH WILL WITHDRAW A COMPETITOR FROM ANY FURTHER COMPETITION. Any known scratches, for reasons of injury, illness or absence, will be appreciated and accepted at the Announcer's table, to assist the Referees in the operation of the meet.

For a competitor(s) participating in more than the allowable number of events, the competitor(s) shall be disqualified from that event and further competition.

For failing to compete in all races, heats and rounds for which he/she has qualified or entered, the competitor shall be disqualified from further competition unless the Deck Referee determines that illness or injury has forced the competitor to withdraw. The competitor shall not be disqualified from events in subsequent rounds for which he/she has previously qualified.

AWARDS

1st-3rd place, Boy's Champion, Girl's Champion. Most Spirited. Best Dressed in the Holiday Spirit. Awards should be picked up AFTER the meet at the pool entrance nearest the blocks.

Ages 9-12: \$6.00 (includes entry into both sessions)
8 & U: Free
3. Additional heat sheets can be purchased for \$2.00.
4. Hospitality. Hospitality will be located on the near side of the deck by the boy's prelim pool. Snacks and beverages will be available at all time AND breakfast and dinner MEALS will be provided for officials and coaches.
5. Meet T-shirts and travel mugs will be available for purchase prior to the meet. Limited quantities will be available for purchase at the meet.
