	met or exceeded the regional qualification.					
	<ul> <li>Qualifying standards will be calculated using 8<sup>th</sup> place times from the previous year</li> </ul>

	• Each school is allowed one relay per event.					
FORMAT and	All swimming events will be timed finals. Times on the scoreboard are unofficial. Results					
PENALTIES:	will be posted on the pool deck and in the hallway.					
	<ul> <li>This meet will be run in a championship format.</li> <li>SCRATCH. A scratch will withdraw a competitor from any further competition.</li> </ul>					
	<ul> <li>If a swimmer misses an event and does not declare a false start they unable to participate</li> </ul>					
	• If a swimmer misses an event and does not declare a faise start they unable to participate in the rest of the meet.					
	DECLARED FALSE START. A competitor may withdraw from an individual event without further penalty with a declared false start. Notice must be given to the Deck Deferse.

	Information to send:					
	Hy-Tek Team Manager entry file. Must be in short course yards.					
	Hy-Tek Team Manager entry report with PROOF OF TIME. When printing the					
	report click on "Include Proof of Time" located upper right under 'Other Options'.					
	Relay cards will be used and must be turned into the lane timers prior to the event. Relay					
	names submitted on the relay cards must be from individuals listed on the official Master					
	Entry List. The Master Entry List must include "relay-only" swimmers. Only the four					
	swimmers declared on the card, including relay lead-off swimmers, are permitted to					
	report to the blocks to compete.					
	<ul> <li>Once all entries have been received and verified, a psych sheet will be sent out to all</li> </ul>					
	teams. After the psych sheet has been sent, no changes, substitutions, or additions can					
	be made to the individual events.					
	By submitting entries, coaches are certifying that all swimmers are eligible and achieved					
	times at VHSL meet during the 2018-2019 season.					

OBSERVED SWIMS FOR USA SWIMMING	<ul> <li>This meet will be observed in accordance with USA Swimming Rules for the purpose of receiving a reportable USA time or record.</li> </ul>						
AWARDS:	<ul> <li>Team Champion Trophy: Boys and Girls.</li> <li>Medals: 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>TH</sup> place for individuals and relays.</li> <li>Teams should pick up awards at the awards table located in hospitality.</li> </ul>						
SCORING:	<ul> <li>Individual: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1</li> <li>Relay: 40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2</li> </ul>						
SAFETY:	<ul> <li>Swimmers enter the water feet first during scheduled warm-up time and any time in warm up/cool down area.</li> <li>All athletes, coaches, and spectator must follow facility rules and any directions/request made by facility staff or lifeguards. Injuries must be reported to lifeguards and meet director immediately.</li> </ul>						
SEEDING	<ul> <li>All individual and relay events will be pre-seeded. Swimmers are to report directly to the starting area as called. Relay cards for the relay will be distributed in the coaches' packet before warm-ups. Coaches are asked to designate the FOUR (4) competitors in the correct order, choosing from the names listed on the Master Entry List, and have the relay swimmers submit the relay card to the lane timers when they report to the blocks for the event</li> </ul>						
TIMERS and VOLUNTEERS	<ul> <li>All participating schools will need to provide 2 volunteers to assist with timing, posting results, and/or deck marshalling. A sign-up genius will be created for volunteers to sign- up. Timer lane assignments and volunteer assignments will be emailed out once entries are submitted. Volunteers that are assigned responsibilities will be admitted for FREE inte the event. Volunteers check in at the volunteer table located behind the steps just inside the pool entrance doors.</li> </ul>						
STATE QUALIFYING	<ul> <li>The top 5 finishers in each individual event and the top 4 finishers in each relay in the Class 4, Region B Meet qualify for the Class 4 State Swim Meet.</li> <li>Individuals or relays may also qualify for the state meet by meeting the Class 4 State Swim Standards at a regular season meet or a VHSL-sanctioned invitational meet.</li> <li>Refer to the State invitation for further clarification.</li> </ul>						
MEET RESULTS	<ul> <li>Meet results will be e-mailed to all coaches as soon as possible and no later than February 9th, 9:00am.</li> </ul>						

GENERAL INFORMATION	<ul> <li>Admission: \$7.00 for spectators. Passes will be accepted at the door (VHSL, VIAAA, VSBA, VHSCA, VASSP, NASSP, VASS). Authorized Press credentials will be recognized.</li> <li>Swimmer/Spectator: Each team is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer or spectator who violates Aquatic Center rules (posted at the pool) is subject to disqualification and removal from the facility. No shaving allowed.</li> <li>Deck Access: Access to the pool deck will be strictly controlled. Swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers ONLY on the pool deck. Swim teams will be given seating assignments on the pool deck.</li> <li>Spectator Seating: Spectators sit in the grandstands overlooking the pool.</li> <li>Team Banners: Banners can be hung at the facility. See lifeguards about putting banners on steel wire behind your team area (bring zip ties) or on the wall (painter's tape ONLY).</li> <li>Hospitality: Light food and drinks will be provided to coaches and officials.</li> <li>Concessions: Will be available.</li> </ul>
