

HANOVER VS MAGGIE WALKER JANUARY 9, 2019

Outstanding meet! 52% best times. Great pacing on events with strong finishes. Even with a dq of a first place relay the boys won. The girls were neck and neck and almost claimed their first victory again Maggie Walker.

We only won 5 out of 22 events: Delaney Childs won the 100 back, Luke Daley won the 200 individual medley in a nail biter, Jack Hufner won the 500 free, Jacob Eisele won the 100 free, and Taylor Scholten, Claire Grant, Meghan Powers, and Caroline Blaser won the Girl's 200 freestyle relay.

We won this meet because of our superior depth across the board. Every relay scored with the Girl's 200 free relays going 1-2. When Maggie Walker took a first place we were usually there for 2nd and 3rd and in seven of the sixteen individual events, Hanover placed all three scorers in the top 4.

The boys were led by JR Luke Daley (1st-200IM, 2nd-100 fly), JR Jack Hufner (1st-500 free, 2nd-200 free), Jacob Eisele (1st-100 free, 5th-100 breast) and JR Daniel Richardson (2nd-100 free 2nd-100 back). The girls were paced by FR Delaney Childs (1st-100 back, 3rd-50 free), SO Meghan Powers (2nd-50 free, 2nd-100 fly), SO Natalie Culley (2nd-200 free, 3rd-100 back), and SR Claire Grant (3rd-200 free, 3rd-100 free)

First time 500 freestyle swimmers: Henry Atkinson, Caleb Mittelstaedt, Ellie Morrison.

Alex Destephanis, Kirsten Powers, Emily Tucker, and Danielle Woolard all swam their first 200 freestyles while Nicholas Ligday and Danielle Varner swam their first 200 individual medleys.

New Time Standards Achieved.

If you make a State, Regional, or Hawk Invitational qualifying standards, this means you have qualified for that meet and are ELIGIBLE to participate that event. This is not a guarantee as we have multiple swimmers that qualify for these meets and we are limited in how many swimmers can compete in each event.

If you qualify for States in a relay event, this does necessarily mean you will go to States on the relay. The relay has qualified for States. We can swim any four swimmers on the relay.
