Day 1- Wednesday, September 18th

Depart Seattle for Milan, Italy.

Day 2- Thursday, September 19th Milan

Arrive Milan. We'll enjoy a half day tour of the **Bosco Verticale** (Vertical Forest), an urban reforestation project of 2 towers dedicated to reducing pollution and restoring nature to the city. Later, we'll visit the famous **II Cimitero Monumentale**. Though seemingly a strange vacation destination, the Monumental Cemetery is virtually an open-air museum filled with Greek temples, ornate obelisks and life-size sculptures.

Day 4- Saturday, September 21st Lakes

Lunch is served in a local osteria (a place serving simple food and wine), followed by a guided tour of the town. Later, we will check in to our hotel in the lakeside town of Lecco.

D'Orcia region- some of the best scenery in Italy and an UNESCO World Heritage Site! We'll explore Pienza and Chianciano villages and have lunch in the tiny medieval town of **Monticchiello**. We end the day with a visit to the famous **La Foce Gardens** overlooking the hills of this beauty- filled region.

Today we move on to Florence, but first we'll explore the **Clay Hills**- one of the most unique landscapes in Tuscany. We'll visit the 14th C. monastery of **Monte Oliveto Maggiore**, home to frescoed masterpieces by Sodoma and Signorelli. Next, we'll continue to the **Madonna Bella Farm** outside Siena where we'll see the olive groves and vineyards and learn how olive oil and fresh/dried pasta is processed. We'll enjoy a food and wine pairing feast-all from the farm.
