

## **AEVNT - MWI Educational Scholarship 2017**

### Information, Criteria and Application Form



MWI Animal Health and the Academy of Equine Veterinary Nursing Technicians (AEVNT) are teaming up to provide a generous one-time scholarship to assist a 2017 AEVNT applicant or current AEVNT member in good standing with \$1000 to be used toward registration, travel and lodging to attend the 2017 AAEP/AAEVT Annual Convention in San Antonio, TX. Through the dedication of Jessie Loberg, an AAEP/AAEVT Advisory Board member, the AEVNT Executive Director, and MWI territory manager, this scholarship is focused on helping AEVNT candidates or active members continue the pursuit for quality continuing education.

The intent of the scholarship is to assist an AEVNT applicant or active member with the travel, lodging and registration costs involved with attending, and or taking the AEVNT examination at the AAEP/AAEVT Annual Convention. The one-time scholarship award is intended to be \$1,000 per recipient. Scholarships will be awarded by the AEVNT Executive Board.

#### Criteria:

- Notification will be made in November by the AEVNT President via a phone call followed by an official award letter. Scholarships will be awarded to the recipient at the AAEP/AAEVT Annual Convention. Attendance at the membership luncheon is not required in order to receive the scholarship, however, is encouraged.
- A successful scholarship applicant will be expected to complete guidelines outlined below for which the scholarship is awarded. If the successful candidate does not use the scholarship monies for the purpose intended, he/she will repay all monies to AEVNT, or such proportion as the panel may determine.

All scholarship applicants that meet the following eligibility requirements may apply for the scholarship:

- Applicants must be current AAEP/AAEVT members in good standing and at the time of application.
- Provide a letter of recommendation from an AAEP Veterinarian, Diplomat or current VTS.
- Applicants must have had their AEVNT application accepted to sit for the for examination in at the 2017 AAEP/AAEVT Annual Convention or be considered an active AEVNT member in good standing.
- Applicant must be registered for the 2017 AAEP/AAEVT Annual Conference in San Antonio, Tx.
- Applicant must be currently working as a veterinary technician in an equine or mixed large animal practice.

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:** All applications must be received no later than October 1, 2017

Complete application packages shall include:

1. **Completed application form** below.
2. **Current CV or Resume** including previous and current employment, with dates, giving brief details of job titles and duties, including names of organization, association or practice address.
3. **Short Essay** describing what sets the applicant apart as an equine nurse and how this scholarship would help. Provide detail about the kind of nursing care you provide to your patients. If you are a current academy member please provide details for what you have done as part of the AEVNT so far, such as: speaking, journal writing, mentorship. Essay should be one typed page in length.
4. **Proof of Registration** for the 2017 AAEP/AAEVT Annual Convention in San Antonio, Tx.
5. **A letter of recommendation** from an AAEP Veterinarian, Diplomat or current VTS.
