

# WALK AT MARSTON MORETAINE – 18 OCTOBER 2015

## THE MILLENNIUM COUNTRY PARK

The Marston Vale Millennium Country Park covers 225 hectares and is a fabulous mix of woodland, grassland, meadow, lakes and wetland habitats criss-crossed by 17 kilometres of traffic free, surfaced cycle paths, grass footpaths and bridle ways. There's a fantastic surfaced path that takes walkers through the beautiful Wetlands Nature Reserve.



There are surfaced paths, numerous grass footpaths and bridleways totalling around the Millennium Park. There's a signpost and map at every entry point, also a wide variety of guided walks.



## Dog Walkers

Responsible dog owners are welcome to use the Millennium Country Park but as the Park is a haven for lots of birds and small mammals, dogs must be kept on a lead or under close control.

Dog bins are provided at regular intervals on main paths, and if necessary the Centre's reception will be glad to offer you a couple in exchange for a donation.

Drinking water for dogs is available at The Forest Centre.
