TIDYING UP YOUR BGV'S TAIL - AND UNDER IT

What you need

- * Metal comb
- * Stripping knife
- * Serrated scissors
- * Sharp scissors

Your BGV's tail hair grows just as it does on the remainder of the body.

First of all, using a metal comb, go through the tail carefully to remove any tangles or knots.

By combing the hair underneath downwards, you can see what needs to be removed.







The tail should be well furnished with hair though taper gradually towards the tip.

Either with a stripping knife, or finger and thumb, work your way down towards the end, removing any excess hair but making sure you retain the gradual tapering shape.



Although not vital for a GBGV, remove excess hair at the end. Do this by using either serrated scissors or stripping knife.

Under the tail should not be neglected.

Make sure there are no knots and the area is not soiled.

Then strip away excess hair.



Next, close to the vent, use scissors to *carefully* remove any hair or mats. This will help to keep the area clean.
