Now a veteran, O'Brien's Caldewriver Despicable Me (Jayanel Edwardo ex Jayanel Daisy Doo) went BV. RDCC was awarded to the Puckett's Soletrader Bobs Your Uncle (Ch Taglines Double Your Fun with Soletrader ex Soletrader Jessie Jay) and DCC/BOB to Robertson & Doherty's Ch Soletrader Magic Mike (Multi Ch Boom Chicago v Tum-Tum's Vriendjes ex Ch Soletrader Peek a Boo) who went on to win the Hound Group judged by Stuart Milner.
