## <u>Tri-County Table Tennis Tournament</u> <u>Rules and Regulations (Please Read)</u>

1) Tournament management may modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total entrants or total entries by event. Fees for canceled events will be refunded.

2) USATT dress code & all other USATT rules will be enforced.

3) All events will be 2 out of 3 games except Open, Open Doubles, Woman's, O-50, \*\*\* Star, \*\* Star, and \* Star events which will be 3 out of 5 games.

4) Do not enter 2 events with the same starting time, and no more than 5 total events.

5) The star events \*\*\*,\*\*,\*, are based on current BA Club ratings. Anyone without a star level, and wanting to enter these events must request permission from tournament director.

6) Club rating Star events are as of 11/24/18

7) Age cutoff for the junior events, and O-50 are as of 12/1/18.

8) If you end up having a conflict with 2 matches being assigned at the same time, you must come to the control desk to have this issue resolved.

9) Any questions regarding the tournament, eligibility, or entry should be directed to Brad Balmer at (918) 240-7465.

10) Some events will have a limit on entrants, so please enter early....

11) Open events will have seedings based on all data the tournament committee has available.

12) If you are late for your events start time, you will be subject to being forfeited.

13) Entry Deadline is 11/29/18 for all events, except for the novice and junior events. If open slots are still available for these events, we will allow entry up to 1 hour before the scheduled starting time.

14) This event is open to residents of Wagoner, Tulsa, and Rogers county plus regular players from the Broken Arrow Ping Pong Club and the Tulsa Table Tennis Club.

15) By agreement signed on application, this gives us the right to photograph and publish pictures obtained at this event unless participant notifies tournament committee ahead of time.

**Event eligibility notes:** O-50 is for players that have turned 50 by tournament date 12/01/18, and older. Junior events are for youth that have turned the stated age by tournament date, and younger. Junior players can enter more than one junior event they qualify for. Novice event is for first time tournament players over the age of 15 and a club rating of under 600.

\* star club rated players can also enter higher rated events including \*\*, & \*\*\*. The parent/child event includes grandparent, step parent, aunt, uncle over the age of 18, and related to the junior, who's age needs to be 13 or under. Jr. doubles is for youth aged 18 and under. Junior open includes boys and girls. Open, Open doubles and Women have no age restrictions.

## Entrants need to have a general knowledge of rules and score keeping.

Serves need to be executed above the table and behind the end line and thrown up before contact.
