**Ministry:**

ES sports will return to Guatemala with both a guy's team and girls' team. We will be ministering to students through basketball in school assemblies, and working with students in Physical education classes. We will also be hosting basketball clinics and compete against local club teams and likely the national team. Use your talents in basketball to share your faith. High school varsity experience is highly encouraged but not required.

**Flights**

Minneapolis – Guatemala City – August 3

Guatemala City – Minneapolis – August 11

**Important dates (Final price set: February 1, 2019)**

Nov. 2 – **Early bird registration** – application and forms (consent, Pastoral reference, background check) & \$200 non-refundable deposit is due = \$50 price reduction of the trip

Nov. 30 – **\$200 Registration is due**

Jan. 25 – First payment of **\$600** is due

All forms must be in, after this date = \$25 late fee

Feb. 18–19 – Mandatory AIM Training/Called conference

Mar. 15 – Second payment of **\$550** is due

May 3 – Final payment of **\$550** is due

May 17 – All money must be in or a \$50 late fee applied to account

June 7 – If payment is still due – trip will be cancelled

**Passports:**

A passport is required for everyone participating in this AIM trip and is not included in the trip cost. The current passport fee is \$135 for adults and \$105 for a minor. Process time is 4-6 weeks. Everyone should apply for a passport the same time they decide to go on the trip. Visit [www.travel.state.gov/passport](http://www.travel.state.gov/passport) for more information. Two color copies of your passport are due March 15, 2019.

# For Every Student...ES Sports

## **Training day:**

The E.S. Sports training camp will take place in the Twin Cities (Minneapolis, Mn.) on August 2, 2019. The statewide AIM training day coincides with the Destination Campus conference on February 17-18, 2019. Registration for this event is included in the cost of the trip. You will meet all the other AIM participants including the ones on your team. You will be given instruction from experienced travelers and missionaries on how to prepare for an AIM trip and what to expect on your trip. Each Aimer will be required to complete the “**watermark**” discipleship program that will be explained at the training day.

## **Typical day:**

Morning/afternoon – ½ of a game of basketball vs. local high school team – speaking about making positive choices, morals & values or conducting Physical Education classes for students.

Night – Host basketball clinics, play game vs. local club or national teams – share faith at halftime and after

## **Vaccinations:**

We recommend consulting your health care provider at least 6 weeks before departure to inquire about recommended vaccinations for your AIM trip. ## **Flights and Trip Cost:**

Airlines frequently change flight schedules, which may affect departure and arrival times. Recent fuel tax surcharge irregularities require the trip cost to be subject to change. **Trip cost includes:** round trip plane tickets, housing, transportation, meals in country, travel insurance, AIM bag, ES Sports apparel, training day, ministry material and sightseeing.

## **Fundraising:**

Each AIM participant should consult with his / her pastor about fundraising opportunities. Sending support letters to friends and family is a great way to ask for prayer and financial support. Sample fundraising letters are included in this packet. Money donated by friends and family members should be sent directly to the participant’s home church, their donations are tax-deductible.
