Ministry:

The Atlanta Dream Center's short-term mission trips are designed to equip missionaries with the skills to lead, empower them to be bold in their faith and establish a culture of missions in their everyday life. The students experience firsthand how to serve others in vulnerable communities, homeless shelters and challenging urban environments while making real, tangible differences in the lives of others. Team members feed the hungry, give comfort to the exploited, hug children who are in desperate situations, see the miracle of spiritual transformation and watch miracles take place right before their eyes.

Important dates (Final price set: February 1, 2019)

Nov. 2 – **Early bird registration** – application and forms (consent, Pastoral reference, background check) & \$200 non-refundable deposit is due = \$50 price reduction of the trip

Nov. 30 - **\$200 Registration is due**

Jan. 25 – First payment of **\$375** is due

All forms $\underline{\text{must}}$ be in, after this date = \$25 late fee

Feb. 17–18 – Mandatory AIM Training/Called conference

Mar. 15 – Second payment of **\$350** is due

May 3 – Final payment of **\$350** is due

May 17 - All money must be in or a \$50 late fee applied to account

June 7 – If payment is still due – trip will be cancelled

Passports:

A passport is not required to participate on this AIM trip.

Vaccinations:

We recommend being up-to-date on all shots that are required for public school attendance.

Trip cost includes: Called conference, housing, meals, travel insurance, AIM bag, AIM t-shirt, AIM water bottle, day off activities.

Training:

Each AIM participant is expected to be involved in training for their trip. The statewide AIM training day coincides with the Called conference on February 17 - 18, 2019. Registration for this event is included in the cost of the trip. You will meet all the other AIM participants including the ones on your team. You will be given instruction from experienced travelers and missionaries on how to prepare for an AIM trip and what to expect on your trip. Each Aimer will be required to complete the "watermark" discipleship program that will be explained at the training day.

Fundraising:

Each AIM participant should consult with his / her pastor about fundraising opportunities. Sending support letters to friends and family is a great way to ask for prayer and financial support. Two sample fundraising letters are included in this packet. Money donated by friends and family members should be sent directly to the participant's home church. Their donations are tax-deductible. There are some additional fundraising tips on our website: www.minnesotaaim.com. Donations must not be written out to Aim participants, they must be written out to the local church or AIM to be considered tax-deductible.
