

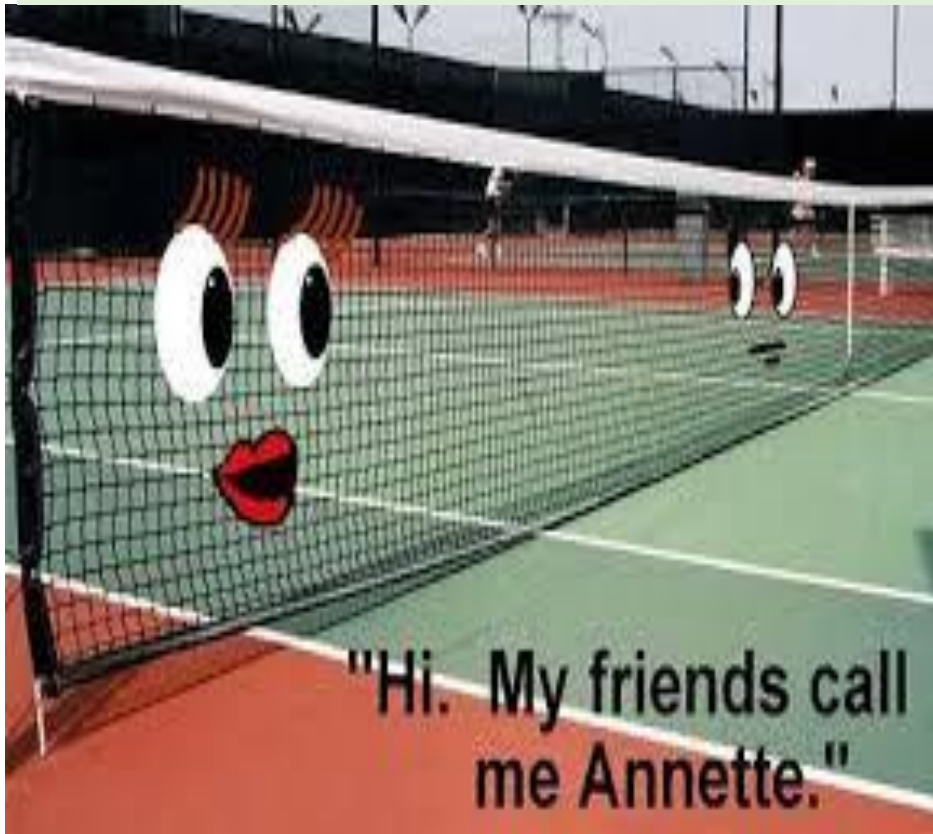

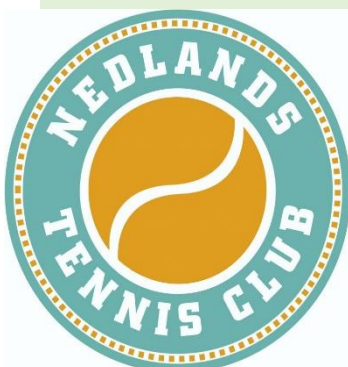

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S COURT

Dear loyal Members of Nedlands Tennis Club....

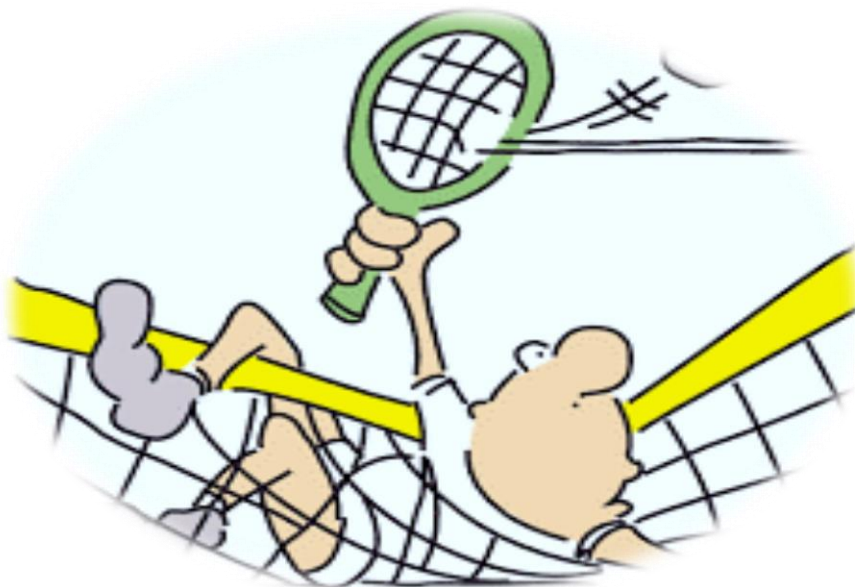

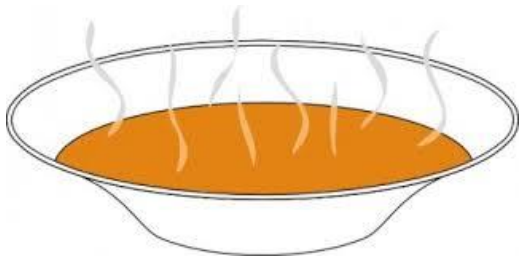

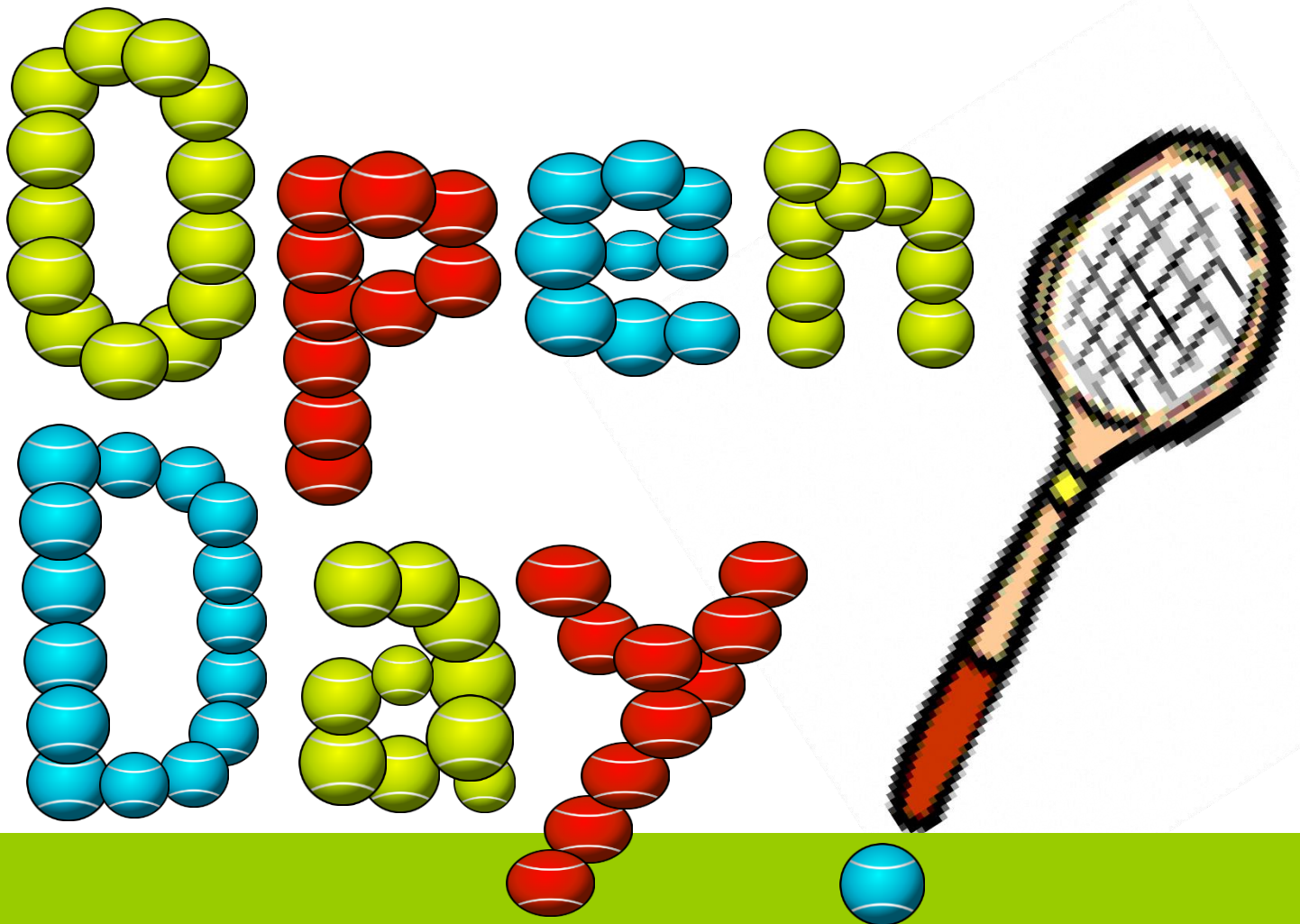
