INTRODUCE LEARNING TOOLS TO IGNITE CHANGE BY EDUCATING, MOTIVATING, AND CONNECTING



Miss In Action (MIA) Program: Equips young girls with leadership skills and knowledge, and the power to take action.

Financial Literacy Program: Provides key concepts and skills related to personal money management, finance basics, and financial responsibility.

Leadership development program: Teaches youth to identify and practice the essential qualities of leadership and address the following topics: Conflict Resolution; Political Activism; Networking & Career Planning.

LEARNING TOOLS



Collected 1,000 books and raised \$600 to create a library for 4th-8th grade students (the school serves about 1,335 students) in Ghana.
