High School Student Intern Program Information

For 30 years, the Tidewater Winds has provided a valuable training platform for Tidewater's advanced high school musicians through our Student Intern Program. This program provides an opportunity for high school students to gain professional performance experience during our summer season. Each student intern is paired with a professional musician to mentor them throughout their time with the "Winds." Student Interns are encouraged to seek advice/help with the music or any other aspect of playing with the band. At the end of the season, the student intern is evaluated on preparedness, musical ability, deportment and progress within the group. These evaluations will then be made available to the student.

We encourage you to consider this opportunity for advanced students. All applicants to the program must meet the following requirements for our High School Student Intern Program:

- 1. Applicants must be a member of the top All-District Concert or Symphonic Band, and/or a member of the All-Virginia Band, currently enrolled in a public or private school band program.
- 2. Applicants must complete the enclosed Student Intern Registration form, complete with band director and parent signatures.
- 3. Applicants must have a signed recommendation from their band director or private teacher. **Please make sure recommendations are submitted with this registration form.**
- 4. All applicants must be available during the month of July. **All rehearsals are mandatory.** As per policy, if you are unable to attend a scheduled rehearsal, you will not be eligible to play that particular week. **No exceptions.**
- 5. All applicants must audition on Sunday, May 19th at Foundry UMC (info on pg. 2). Audition materials are available on the website (<u>TidewaterWinds.org</u>), or by request via e-mail at <u>PerManager.TW@Gmail.com</u>.
- 6. If selected, each intern is required at the end of the season to provide a short essay recapping their experience as a part of the Tidewater Winds ensemble.

Applications submitted after the deadline of May 5th are not guaranteed an audition for the 2019 Season. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted** (*e.g.* missing teacher recommendation, missing availability info, missing signature, etc.).

Please check your calendar with our 2019 Summer Season dates on pg. 3. Place a mark that best describes your availability for each performance listed. Rehearsals are always on Sundays from 2:30-5:30.

As per policy, if you are unavailable for a Sunday rehearsal, you are ineligible to perform at all that week. No exceptions.

Concerts always have a 7:30 start time unless specifically noted. Please remember to consider your commute to the performance location. A 60-45 minute call time is encouraged, while a 30 minute call time is compulsory.

The Tidewater Winds Big Band is a smaller group comprised of members from the Concert Band which uses traditional big band instrumentation (sax/reed doubles, trumpets, trombones, and rhythm section). If you are auditioning on an instrument used in that group and interested, please mark your availability for those dates, as well.

"Big Band Only" dates only require members of the Tidewater Winds Big Band and not the full Concert Band.

If you are not a part of the Tidewater Winds Big Band, you will not be contracted for those events.
