A BILL

TO AUTHORIZE: A MANDATORY RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM IN ALL PUBLIC FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GIRLS STATE OF WYOMING, THAT

Section 1. All entities supported with public funding, within the State of Wyoming, shall promote and provide for a recycling collection program in all public facilities. (a) The recycling collection program shall include, but is not limited to, the collection of recyclable paper, plastic, glass, and aluminum by providing separate designated containers for each recyclable product.

Section 2. Definitions: (a) As used in this act: (1) Public Facilities means all buildings, parks, and other public places maintained and/or supported with public funding.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately.
