ASSEMBLY CHANGE

PARKING

You have probably noticed that the Belmont City Council did some major road works over the summer break. They have added many more parking bays and a designated pedestrian crossing area. The next stage for us is to apply for a properly demarcated "Zebra Crossing". This does involve several surveys and can take up to one year. In the meantime you will usually find myself or Mr Major resplendent in our high vis, ensuring the safety of the children crossing at the end of each school day. Please encourage your children, even if you are crossing with them to cross at the specific crossing area just to the right of the school sign at the front of the school. I will keep you updated regarding the crosswalk application.



STANDARISED TESTING

Classroom teachers usually conduct testing at the start of the year. We also have On Entry testing taking place for our Pre Primary, Year 1 and Year 2 students between weeks 2 and 6. As a whole school we are also conducting Standardised testing in Numeracy, Comprehension Spelling and Vocabulary for our Pre Primaries through to Year 6. The results from these tests help us to plan for a more individualised approach with regard to teaching your child. They also help us to program some whole class focus areas. VALUES PROGRAM

Below is a brief description about the goals linked to the PATHS program

The P.A.T.H.S .program being used at our school has five goals:

1. Increasing student's abilities to think and solve problems for themselves
2. Increasing student's abilities to use thinking skills to act responsibly and maturely
3. Improving student's understanding of themselves and others
4. Improving student's feelings about themselves (that is ,improving their self –esteem)
5. Increasing student's abilities to learn more effectively in the classroom environment


