GOOD STANDING

One of the many positive programs we run at the school is the Good Standing Reward. This is linked directly to

our TOD (Treat Others Decently) behaviour program.

Children start each semester with "Good Standing" They keep their Good Standing by following rules of behaviour and good conduct, wearing school uniform (including the wearing of the school hat), arriving on time to class – especially at the start of the day and bringing a note (email or phone call) to explain absences or lateness.



At the end of each semester those with good standing are given a reward (usually an excursion or activity).
