### **Required Sea Service:**

- To apply for the Yacht Junior Steward/ess CoC no previous Sea Service is required
- To apply for the Yacht Senior Steward/ess CoC a minimum of **12 months** Yacht Service and **60 days** Guest Service is required.
- To apply for the Yacht Chief Steward/ess Co C a minimum of **24** months Yacht Service and **120 days** Guest Service whilst holding Senior Steward/ess position. (NOTE: This is a further 12 months Yacht Service and 60 days Guest Service from issue of Yacht Senior Steward/ess CoC)
