

Toluca Sportsman's Club Constitution and By-Laws

- The club shall be known as the Toluca Sportsman's Club Inc.
- This club shall be incorporated in its name as a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Illinois.
- The objective of this organization is to provide a safe shooting range, help preserve habitat, and promote the outdoors.
- Application for membership shall be made to any member who will act as a sponsor of such proposed objectives of the clubs goals, with annual dues paid. Expulsion of a member shall be done by voting of secret ballot by majority of members present at a monthly meeting.
- Members who fail to keep their dues current will be dropped from the role ninety (90) days after the due date of the dues. They will not be reinstated until the back dues or a special reinstatement is granted by the officers and directors.
- Limit of 125 members. First come first serve.
- Membership cards will be issued annually.
- Members are to collectively authorize expenditures over \$100 per month.
- The affairs of the association shall be managed by the officers (President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer) and a board of directors.
- Election of President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and three (3) directors shall be held bi-annually. Two (2) directors shall be elected the off year. Elections are to take place at the June meeting.
- At all regularly scheduled general meetings, seven (7) members present shall constitute a quorum providing at least one (1) officer is present to preside. A quorum at a special meeting shall consist of three (3) directors and two (2) officers.
- Dissolution of the organization and disposal of its assets can only be accomplished upon the affirmative vote of 75% of members in effect on the date of the voting, after all debts are paid and the books balance. The remaining balance of proceeds and assets shall be donated to a charitable organization of the voting members' choice.
- No resolution may be adopted by this organization which is political in scope or purpose.
- All members will assist in keeping the club grounds and facilities in a clean and orderly condition.
- All garbage must be taken home or deposited in garbage containers on the grounds. Each member shall be responsible for their own garbage and refuse.
- A membership shall include club privileges for the member's spouse, dependent children under 18 years of age, grandchildren under 16 years of age, or significant other.
- Members, and guest accompanied by members, shall have use of any club facility. Members will be personally responsible for the behavior of the guest. No guest shall be admitted to the grounds unless the entertaining member is present on the grounds.
- Members are to adhere to all rules and by-laws of the club.

All above by-laws can be changed, amended, or added to by a majority vote of the officers and directors.
