

Membership Agreement

In a hive, bees work together to get things done. When every bee does their part, their combined actions create an expansive impact. We want our HIVE to work the same way, so we want to be clear on a few points to make sure we are all working in harmony.

- HAPPY HIVE: Any circumstance that could negatively impact any of our members or staff...well, we want to avoid it. Therefore, we may ask a member to come back on another day if:
 - he/she is having a miserable day and seems to be really struggling and inconsolable.
 *We expect occasionally someone will get grumpy or resistant when asked to do something, that's just part of learning. But time at the HIVE should be positive, constructive, and rewarding overall, so if the member is just not digging it that day, it might be best to come another time.
 - he/she is showing signs of aggression or violent behavior. *Everyone's safety is a top priority.
 - he/she is showing signs of being sick. *Please don't send your member if they are not well. Even minor illnesses can have major consequences for some of our folks. When it comes to germs, sharing is not caring.
- The HIVE is absolutely, positively, and unquestionably a drama-free zone. We encourage communication about any topic, especially if there is an issue with our services, but we insist that all members, volunteers, and staff are treated with respect at all times. This is our Happy Place and any and all drama must be left at the door before entering. Anyone who forgets to leave it and brings it in with them will be asked to take it back out and find another place for it to go. The only drama we can handle is the of the performance variety.
- WEATHER: In the case of inclement weather, we will be following Warren County Public Schools. If they are closed for weather, we will be, too. Please check local listings for those closings.
- FEES: We promise to do our best to give you caviar services on a burger budget, but we do need those little minor fees paid.

The HIVE is not a care provider. Anyone needing personal care, supervision, or assistance participating or engaging in activities MUST have a mentor with them who has experience in how to care for and direct them. Likewise, if there is a history of aggressive behavior, regardless of independence, the member must have a mentor with them at all times who is trained and experienced in managing behaviors and capable of removing them from class if necessary.

We are not a daycare and do not bill Medicaid or insurance. Anyone requiring one on one assistance will need to bring their own support person with them.
