### #Empty Yourself

**“Empty yourself because Christ emptied Himself for you”**

In the penultimate week of our series on UNITY, we will be looking at HUMILITY. In conjunction with our series scripture, we will be looking at Philippians 2:5-11. Paul writes to the church in Philippi due to there being a disagreement between two leaders and he encourages them to find humility in their hearts. Being humble is a key aspect of entering the Kingdom and we are encouraged to find peace with each other in spite of differences, being right, getting our own way or getting our point across.

Humility isn't easy and it takes a change of focus and an emptying of oneself in order to make room for the Spirit of God to make room in our hearts. “A cup cannot be filled if it is already full”

***“In your lives you must think and act like Christ Jesus. Christ himself was like God in everything. But he did not think that being equal with God was something to be used for his own benefit. But he gave up his place with God and made himself nothing”***– Philippians 2:5-7

### REFLECTION

1. Remember who's in charge—& praise Him! Its hard keep things in perspective if we don't remember who is Lord! - Psalm 90 is a good place to start.
2. Pray for a humble heart - Ask the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to the ways in which pride gets in the way of your relationships.
3. Pay more attention to your own faults than to the flaws of others.- Confess your failings, but don't obsess—move on!
4. Don't hide behind your dignity—its pride's favourite hiding place. Your real value lies in God's eyes, not in the eyes of the world. Remember: “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble” (1 Peter 5:5)
5. Worship isn't about you - .Give all of your heart and mind to God.
6. Serve others -The fastest way to humility is the way Christ chose. “For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve...”Mk 10:45
