Over the next 5 weeks we will be reflecting on Paul's teaching of love - how to love GOD and OTHERS well.

This week we will be reflecting on a HOLY LOVE

Paul writes that we need to wake up from our spiritual sleepiness, if we stay asleep we cannot be spiritually ready. The reality is that we often are spiritually asleep when it comes to sin.

We fail to see the effect or consequence of it in our lives and the lives of others and therefore we become accepting of it instead. However, Paul teaches us that sin must not be delighted in but instead for it to turn us to sorrow and mourning because of the separation it brings. What is the answer.....a prescription of repentance

*'Besides this, you know what time it is, how it is now the moment for you to wake from sleep. For salvation is nearer to us now than when we became believers'* – Romans 13:11
