
# Mark 9: 2 – 13 – The Transfiguration


## Mark 9: 2 – 13 – The Transfiguration






<sup>5</sup> He was still speaking when, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." <sup>6</sup> When the disciples heard this, they fell on their faces and were terrified. <sup>7</sup> But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and have fear." 8 And when they lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only.

## Mark 9: 2 – 13 – The Transfiguration






<sup>9</sup> And as they were coming down the mountain, Jesus commanded them, "Tell no one the vision, until the Son of Man is raised from the dead." 10 And the disciples asked him, "Then why do the scribes say that first must come?" <sup>11</sup> Elijah answered, "Elijah does come, and he will restore all things. 12 But I tell you that Elijah has already come, and they did not recognize him, but did to him whatever they pleased. So also the Son of Man will certainly suffer at their hands." <sup>13</sup> Then the disciples understood that he was speaking to them of John the Baptist.



# Six days before the transfiguration ...




Jesus asked his disciples: Who do people say I am? Who do you say I am?



#### Malachi 4: 4 - 5

"Remember the law of <u>my servant Moses</u>, the decrees and laws I gave him at <u>Horeb</u> for all Israel. See, I will send the <u>prophet Elijah</u> to you before that great and dreadful day of the Lord comes."



## 1 Kings 19: 8, 11

So he [**Elijah**] got up and ate and drank. Strengthened by that food, he travelled forty days and forty nights until he reached **Horeb**, the mountain of God ... The LORD said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the LORD, for the LORD is about to pass by."

### Exodus 24: 1, 15 - 16



Then the LORD said to Moses, "Come up to the LORD, you and <u>Aaron, Nadab and Abihu</u> ... When Moses went up on the mountain, the cloud covered it, and the glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai. For <u>six days</u> the cloud covered the mountain, and on the seventh day the LORD called to Moses from within the cloud.

Exodus 34: 29 - 30

When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant law in his hands, he was not aware that <u>his face was radiant because he had spoken with the LORD</u>.

"This is my **Son**, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. **Listen to him!**"


#### **Deuteronomy 18: 16 - 18**
