You are welcome to join us for the weekly dinner, whether you need food assistance or not. We would appreciate a few more people to help us better serve and support our guests; this need not be a weekly commitment. Please contact the church if you can assist in greeting our guests, serving or cooking the dinner, or putting together boxes of food. You can also help by getting the word out in the community that we offer this service to our neighbors.

The pantry is always in need of non-perishable food, especially pasta and pasta sauce; macaroni and cheese; dry cereal; soup; peanut butter and jelly; canned fruit; canned tuna or meat; and potatoes.

- **Wednesday, March 1** – Ash Wednesday. No evening service. Drop in any time between 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. for a private imposition of ashes and a short litany of repentance with Pastor Diane.
- **Sundays, March 5 – April 9** – Lenten sermon series: “Only in John: Stories Found Only in John’s Gospel.”
- **Sunday, April 9** – Palm Sunday with children’s procession, the waving of palms, and lots of hallelujahs!
- **Friday, April 14** – Good Friday evening service, with a reading of Jesus’ crucifixion narrative.
- **Sunday, April 16** – Easter! Pastor Diane needs to hear from you if you really, really, really want to have that early sunrise service. Otherwise, we’ll have brunch, a 10:30 service, and then an Easter egg hunt for the kids.

It’s every Sunday during worship, after Kids’ Corner.
