

Lady Owls Win Team Championship in L

SHELTON — Adrienne Pitts and Jennifer Marshall of Hartford Public High paced the Owls to the Class L Girls Track Team Championships at Shelton High Saturday.

The Owls finished ahead of the pack with a total of 50 points; North Haven, New Britain and Hall of West Harford followed with 39, 34 and 34 points respectively.

Marshall placed second in the 100-yard dash and second in the 220-yard run. Pitts took first in the 80-yard hurdles with a time of :10.8 and placed second in the 440 run.

Hartford was victorious in the 440-yard relay, Rashidah Adiova, Phyllis Marshall, Pitts and Jennifer Marshall were members of the Owl team, which toured the track in a time of :49.5.
