Petrello Reached Back to Win Javelin Event in State Open

By WOODY ANDERSON SOUTHTON — The challenge stared Jim Petrello in the face. He showed no emotion. Win or lose he's the same.

Saturday at the State Open Track Meet at Southington High School the challenge of his athletic career was thrust before him.

With two throws left in the javelin, Petrello, East Hartford's block of granite, had suddenly lost the lead by four feet.

He started his approach but pulled up before the foul line and walked back to restart his run.

He fired the javelin on a clothes-line trajectory.

It landed 204-5 away to win by eight feet.

"I was worried," said the 5-8 202

senior when he found himself trailing 196-192.

Didn't Think He Had It

Then he messed up his steps and had to restart. But he's done that before so it didn't bother him that much.

"I didn't think it was a 200-footer," said Petrello of his winning throw, the best in the state this year and the first time he had gone over the magic 200-foot barrier.

Last year his best throw was only 175. He had no idea that he would be the best in the state a year later. "I didn't set a goal. All I thought was let's see what happens."

Then just before the football season began last fall he hurt his knee and required surgery. He was out for the year. When the cast was re-

moved he spent most of his free time weightlifting. He worked so intently, in fact, that his therapist ran out of weights for him. He bench presses 340 pounds. He was determined to be in shape for the track season.

Only Two Losses

He only lost twice. He won all but one of the major events — Hartford Public Invitational, Eastern Relays, Big B, Class L sectional, and last week — the Class L title at Windham. He placed second in the Great-er Hartford meet.

Only twice did he fail to throw over 190-feet all season. His failures didn't phase him. "I didn't think about them," he said.

No smiles. No frowns. No emotions. All business. That's Jim Petrello.

Fifty-four high school teams scored in the top event of boys track which brings together the top performers in the four Class Meets held last week.

Bulkeley School New Britain, Class LL champion, rode the gippy legs of Rich Edwards for 12 points, triple jump whiz Dave Mobley for 10 points and triple — high jumper Ed Earls for another 10 en route to a 44-point total. Bulkeley of Hartford, with wins from pole vaulter Rod Desrosiers and its mile relay team, placed second with 32 points followed by Nealy-led Hartford Public with 29 1/2 points and Ridgfield with 24.

Edwards Pulls Again Edwards, stymied by several hamstring pulls over the last two years, won the 100 dash in 9.6 seconds but pulled up limping 50 yards shy of the 220 dash wire. The Houston-bound Edwards hobbled across the finish line in fifth place. He was second before he pulled. Mobley continued his mastery in the triple jump with a 46-5 1/4 leap.

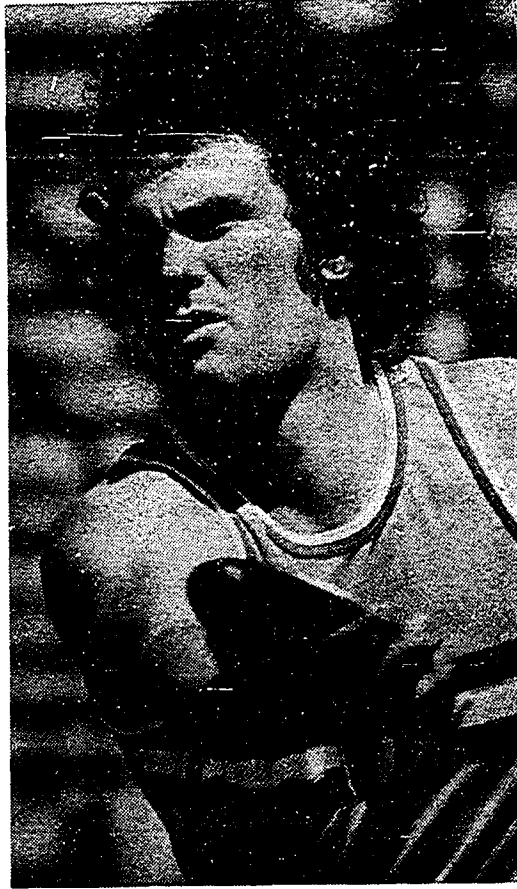
