## A BAD NIGHT FOR HARTFORD. The Public High School Burned.

A little after 2 o'clock this morning the discovery was made that the Hartford

High school was on fire. The alarm was promptly given, and a little later a general alarm was sounded. The mischief had evidently been caused by an overheated furnace.

In a very short time the whole building was in flames, and the best

efforts of the firemen were unavailing to save it. The brilliancy of the blaze recalled the historic Bee Hive and St. Patrick's church fires. The fine building was totally destroyed. It is a sad loss to Hartford.
