HARTFORD HIGH STATE CHAMPION

Beats New Haven in Close Game.

New Haven, Nov. 15.

At Yale Field today the New Haven High School football team went down to defeat at the hands of the Hartford High School, a lone touchdown deciding the game in Hartford's favor. The score was 7 to 0. With the game went the state championship, for Hartford last week beat New Britain by a 33 to 0 score.

A crowd of fair proportions witnessed the game, and from start to finish was thrilled with the excellent play of both teams. Hartford scored in the first period, when with the ball on New Haven's twenty-five yard line, the locals were penalized fifteen yards, thus putting the ball on their ten yard line, from which point the un-state boys carried the ball over.
