

# High School Eleven Defeats New Haven

## Elm City Team Puts Up Stubborn Defense But Hartford Backfield Rips Way Through—"Dutch" Eschholz Is Individual Star.

The Hartford High School football beat the eleven from the New Haven High School yesterday afternoon at Trinity Field, 21 to 0.

The visitors put up a stubborn defense but were forced to give way before the local backs, which were tipping large holes time and again.

For the locals "Dutch" Eschholz at quarterback was the shining light. He carried the team in a perfect manner and ran wild around the ends. He also heaved a forward pass that resulted in a touchdown.

McCoy followed "Dutch" closely for the honor. Smith at center and Captain Drolot, who played the game with a brace on his injured elbow, shone in the line.

### Uncover Trick Plays.

The locals swept their way to victory by using all the tricks of football. Eschholz went over the goal for the first touchdown after the locals had brought the ball from midfield. He second was scored by Crosby, who was on the receiving end of a forward buried by Eschholz. McCoy scored the last touchdown after a series of line plays. In the second quarter, Crosby tackled an opposing back behind the goal for a safety.

There was a crowd of 5,000 at the game when the whistles started the teams off. New Haven had several royal rosters who journeyed to the Capital City to cheer their team. The local student body was out strong.

### Hartford Receives Kick.

Hartford won the toss and Captain Drolot decided to defend the north with the wind in back. Hurley kicked off to McCoy, who caught the ball on his 20-yard line and returned it over one white line before he was felled. On the first line up McCoy tore off three yards over left tackle. Eschholz made the same amount on the other side of the line. Herting failed to gain and McCoy punted to Stumpi on his 40-yard line. He was thrown in his tracks. Crabb made two yards through center. Mills added five more on an end run. Hurley made it first down on a buck through the left of the line.

Stumpi was stopped at the line of scrimmage by Smith. Mills made a scant yard through center. Crabb dropped back and punted to Eschholz on his 30-yard line, who returned the ball to his 40-yard mark before he was tackled. On the next play Eschholz made eight yards on a play over right tackle. McCoy made it first down on an end run. Dunn picked up two yards on a play through the center and Herting on the same kind of a play succeeded in adding five more to the total.

### Safety First Score.

The New Haven line strengthened and McCoy kicked out of bounds to the visitors' 5-yard line. Crabb was thrown for a loss of one yard and on the next play one of the visiting backs fumbled and recovered behind his own goal for the first score of the game. The locals did not like the looks of two points so right after the kick off they took the ball on downs in the middle of the field. McCoy tore off eight yards over left tackle. Eschholz on a wide right end run made eleven yards. Herting tore through the line for five. The local backfield was working like one man. Dunn placed the ball on the 20-yard line on a line buck. McCoy brought it to the 15-yard mark on a skin tackle play. Herting placed the ball four yards nearer the goal and Eschholz on a play over right tackle succeeded in carrying the ball over for the first touchdown of the game. Drolot kicked the goal.

### Eschholz Leaves Game.

Hurley kicked off to Dunn on his 30-yard line, who was thrown in his tracks. McCoy made three yards on a line play. Eschholz bucked the line for five yards but when the pile was cleared he was laying at the bottom. He was removed from the game. Sexton called signals, Dunn went to end and Parker played in his place. McCoy ran around the left end for five yards. Herting slipped through the center for eight yards. Sexton skirted the end for four yards. New Haven came back and held the locals for downs as the quarter ended.

Mills was stopped at the line. Stumpi made two yards on the left side of the line. Hurley kicked to McCoy in the middle of the field. The locals started a march down the field. Sexton on a wide left end run carried the ball to the 35 yard line. McCoy picked up three over left tackle. Herting failed to gain and Parker also failed. McCoy tried a drop kick which was blocked and a Hartford man recovered. Parker made three yards on a line play. McCoy bucked the line for one yard. Sexton made two yards and McCoy missed first down by an inch. Stumpi carried the ball on the next line up for eight yards. Hurley crashed through the center for ten yards before the locals brought him down. This was the only point in the game where the New Haven succeeded in gaining much ground. Mills slipped around left end for eight yards.

### Local Players Get Lecture.

Hartford called time out and Drolot got his men around him and gave them a little lecture. It took effect because they went out and took the ball on downs. McCoy crashed over the left side of the line for five yards. Hartford was penalized fifteen yards for holding. Sexton took the ball and on a wide left end run placed the ball on the visitors' 40 yard line. Parker added two yards on a skin tackle play. Herting advanced the ball five yards on a line buck. McCoy made it first down and Sexton brought the ball eight yards nearer the goal on a off tackle play. The local backs were steadily tackling near the goal but with the ball ten yards from the destination the half ended much to the pleasure of the New Haven players.

At the beginning of the second half, Eschholz took the reins from Sexton. Johnson kicked off to Hurley on his 30 yard line who did not return it a yard. Crabb bucked the line for five yards. Willis made seven yards around end. Stumpi was unable to gain through the line. Hurley added one yard and on the next play he punted to Eschholz who caught the ball on his 25 yard line and returned it twenty-five yards before he was overtaken and downed. McCoy made five yards on a play through the center. Sexton, on an end run made six yards and first down. Eschholz made fifteen yards on a wide end run on the opposite side. McCoy added five more and Herting brought the ball two yards nearer on a line plunge. Sexton went through for five yards.

### Forward Pass Success.

Here Eschholz fooled the visitors. So far in the game the locals used only line plunges and with the ball within scoring distance of the goal the visitors thought that the locals would keep on bucking the line. Eschholz received the ball from center and started off on what seemed to be an end run but stopped suddenly and heaved a forward pass to Crosby, who was free to dash over the remaining three yards for a touchdown. Eschholz kicked the goal.

Johnson kicked the ball to Mills on his 30 yard line who was thrown without a gain. The rest of the period resulted in a punting duel between McCoy and Hurley. The local boy got the best of the duel and as the period closed, New Haven had the ball on its own 30 yard line.

The local forced the down states to kick and Eschholz, receiving the ball on his own 30 yard line, raced over four white marks to the middle of the field before he was thrown. Sexton plowed through for five yards. Herting broke lose and covered ten yards before he was brought down. McCoy ran over right tackle for eight yards. Eschholz on an end run succeeded in placing the ball on the 10 yard line.

### McCoy Scores Final.

McCoy on the next line up carried the ball over for the final touchdown. Eschholz kicked the goal; Johnson kicked off to Hurley who was thrown on his 35 yard line. The New Haven team opened up a forward passing game which succeeded in placing the ball within scoring distance. The local line held and forced Mills to jump back and try a drop kick, which failed. The locals opened up an aerial attack which was successful. McCoy heaved several short passes to Eschholz who caught every one and was never downed until he had made at least eight yards. The locals had the ball on the New Haven 30 yard line as the game ended.
