Play By Play Account Of Hartford High's Victory

First Period.

Hartford High won the toss and chose to Aick off to New Birltain. Cresby sent the oval spinning back to the 25 yard line where Reynolds Srasped the pigskin and ran it back fifteen yards before being thrown. A forward pass was grounded by Baron. On an attempted end run Murphy threw Murtha for a one yard loss. Reynolds dropped back ten yards for a punt and booted to Tremonte, who fumbled the ball and a fleet New Britain wingman fell on the ball on the Hartford 40-yard line. Glernochowshi picked up two yards through right tackle. On a repetition of the play Murphy threw the New Britais halfback os the scrimmage line. Rey-nolds then pontea to the manage hirty-five yard mark and e red jerseyed player swooped down on the ball and picked it p but was downed on the spot. The referee penalized New Britain five yards for falling on their own punt. Van Orden on a skin tackle play gained nine yards. Mur-phy assaluted the center of the red and gold line for three yards and first down. Treinonte crashed over left tackle, for two yards. On an off-tackle play Van Orden pleked up six yards. Murphy hit right guard for first down and the ball was on New Pittality desured down. Britain's 46-yard mark. Tremonte failed in an attempt to gain. Van Orden skirted the New Dritain right end for eight yards. Murphy again made it first down for hie blue and white, hitting the middle of the New Britain line, for four yards. Baron smashed right tackle for eight yards and Van Orden's smash at the line And van Orden's smash at the mo-netted three. Yan Orden was called on again to rush the ball and this time gained the same number of yards. On the next play one of the Hartford linemen was caught using his hands illegally and the local eleven was ponalized fifteen yards. This put the oval on the 34-yard mark, with twenty-two yards to go for first down. Baron and Van Orden were thrown without gain in succession. Then Van Orden made two yards. Green went into the game for Cooney. who received an injury to his ankle, in the first play. On a trick play, Murphy crashed through guard for six yards and the goal posts loomed up big. Agan Murphy was elected to carry the ball and he rammed through the New Britain line for the touch down. Holden fumbled the ball and his hasty attempt to make the extra point failed. Crosby kicked off and the oval fell into the waiting arms of Walker, who was downed in his tracks. Reynolds shot a pass to Walker that netted three yards. In two smashes at the Hartford line Glernochowshi made cight yands. eight yands. Wimbish cut in back of the New Brit-ain line on the next play and threw Murtha for a six yard loss. Baron knocked down a forward pass on the 42-yard line and Reynolds punted to Tremonte on the Hartford 30-yard mark. Second Period.

Holden punted to Reynolds on New

Britain's 35-yard line and it was returned seven yards. Murtha's two attempts to penetrate the Hartford defense were failures only one yard being gained. A punting duel between Holden and Reynolds ensued with New Britain finally getting the ball on Hartford's 25-yard line. Baron broke through the New Britain defense and threw Walker for a five yard loss. A pass, Reynolds to Murtha, netted iwo yards. The toe of Gierochowshi sent the pigskin twirling between the cross-bars for the only fleid goal of the game.

Serier thertford 6, New Urtinia 3, Reynolds kicked oft to Sayers, who ran the kick back seven yards. Tremonte and Murphy each made two mains and Hildan Agre schell 1a, total heave a long forward pass. It was intercepted on the forty-four yard line by McCabe. The Hartford line was like a stonewall and Reynolds was forced to punt after three smashes at the line had gained nothing. Tremonté run back the kick five yards. Van Orden shot over tackle for six yards. Murphy snatched up three more and Van Orden inde It first down. Baron made nine yards through the New Britan line. Murphy was working good and made another first down. The line opened up a hole for Yan Orden and he made eight yarls. Murphy gained three yards and brought the ball to the New Britan 48-yard line. A forward pass was grounded and the trenonte-Van Orden combination gained eleven yards. Daron was then thrown for a five yard loss when he attemped to round left; end. A short forward pass to Tremonde netted four yards. Van Orden brough the ball to the 30-yard line on the usxt play and here the half ended.

Third Period.

Reynolds kicked off to fartford the catcher being downed only after he had vun the ball back thirteen yards. Tremonte and Van Orden each unde flve yards on off-tackle plays and a one yard gain sundwiched in by Murphy gave Hartford first down on Hartford's 46-yard line. Earon zot a fast start and shot through the New Britain line for seven yards. Van Oden tore off four yards but, on the next play, fumbled, the ball going to New Britain, A bad pass from center set New Britain six yards toward their own goal. A short pass to Murtha gained three yards. Murphy gained the yards hurthe function lost flve yards. Murphy gained the ball, wards toward the first on the Ball going for New Britain on the Ball wards to wards fulled to gain he punted to Van Orden who returned the boot twelve yards. Van Orden fumbled and Hartford lost flve yards. Murphy gained two and Holden kicked 'o New Britain on the Ball. A long forward falling on the ball. A long forward falling no heckel down a forward pass. Baron knocked down a forward pass.

end ruin. New Britain attempted double pass and Murphy intercepte it on Hartford's 31-yard line. A wide end run, with Van Orden car rying tim bail, scored the last touch down. Holden made a pretty dro kiek for the extra point.
