

Hartford Swimmers Open Season Today

The Hartford High School swimming squad, which has been practicing for two months under the direction of Coach Larry Amann at the Hartford YMCA pool, will open its 1935 season with a preliminary meet with the Springfield College Freshmen at Springfield Friday night.

The Hilltop squad is a veteran one with Robert Evans, state breast-stroke champion, and Edward Killian, who is to graduate in February, the only member of last year's team, missing from this season's lineup.
