The Hartford team swam the 150 yard medley relay in 1:26.4, better-ing the old mark of 1:27.6. The Capital City trib barely nosed out Warren Harding in this event. The other record breaker was Po-vilaitis of Crosby who turned in a time of 1:06.6 for the 100 yard breatstroke. The former record, sky years old, was 1:12. "Plumb of Warren Harding scored something of an upset when he won the finals of the diving competition after Costello of Meriden had fin-tisled ahead of all qualifiers.
