

Owl Swimmers Increase Win Streak To 24

Waterbury, March 10.--(Special.)
—Hartford High's brilliant array of swimmers, perennial Connecticut High School Swimming League champions turned back Crosby, 43-32 tonight to annex their tenth undisputed league title. In the other years that the league has been in existence Hartford finished in a triple tie for first place.

Tonight's victory extended the Owls' winning streak to 24 and marked their ninth triumph of the season in as many dual meets.

Hartford's 11-point margin of victory, however, was their smallest of the season.

Paul Girdes of Hartford tied the Crosby pool record for the 40-yard free style as he negotiated the distance in 19 and one tenth seconds.
