

Hartford Swimmers Down Crosby To Capture Crown

Owls Take Six of Eight First Places at Waterbury To Secure Fifteenth Consecutive State Scholastic Swimming League Championship

Waterbury, Feb. 18.—(Special.) Hartford High's well-balanced natators won the Connecticut Interscholastic Swimming League title for the fifteenth time tonight by downing Crosby High, 44 to 31 in the Crosby pool.

Coach Larry Amann's Hartford squad copped six of the eight events and took three second places to dominate the meet. It was their ninth straight success within the league and Crosby's first setback after six triumphs.

In addition to taking both relays, Hartford swept the freestyle events with Markovitz taking the 40, Roback the 100 and Viola the 220. The other Owl victory came in the backstroke where Evans prevailed. Garrett in the dive and Mittleman in the breast stroke were Crosby's individual victors.
