

Hartford Fifth In New England Swim At Boston

Boston, March 12.—(Special.)—Coach Larry Amann's Hartford High team finished fifth in the second annual New England Interscholastic Swimming Championships at MIT tonight. The Hartford swimmers placed third in the 200-yard freestyle relay and third in the 150-yard medley relay.

Lemaire of Bristol placed first in the 50-yard freestyle and third in the 100, while Al Stenberg of Hartford Bulkeley finished third and LaBlanc of Hartford fifth in the dive.
