#### **Macadamia Nut Cookies**

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 cup butter, softened
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- · 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2-1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 jars (3-1/2 ounces each) macadamia nuts, chopped
- 2 cups (12 ounces) semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup (6 ounces) white baking chips

#### **Directions:**

- In a large bowl, cream butter and sugars until light and fluffy. Add eggs and vanilla; beat on medium speed for 2 minutes. Combine the flour, baking soda and salt; add to creamed mixture and beat for 2 minutes. Stir in nuts and chips. Cover and refrigerate several hours or overnight.
- Drop by tablespoonfuls 2 in. apart onto ungreased baking sheets. Bake at 375° for 10-12 minutes or until golden brown. Cool on pans for 1 minute before removing to wire racks; cool completely.

<u>Editor's Note:</u> 2 cups of chopped almonds may be substituted for the macadamia nuts. Nutrition Facts:

- 7. The first artificial Christmas tree was made in Germany, fashioned out of goose feathers that are dyed green!

- 9. Common decorations on a Christmas tree each have their specific meanings. Candles the light of the world, the Star at the top is a reminder of the first Christmas night and Candy canes are to represent the Shepherd's cane.
- 10. "Jingle bells" was composed in 1857, and not for Christmas it was meant to be a Thanksgiving song!
- 11. In 1647 Oliver Cromwell, English Puritan leader, banned the festivities of Christmas for being seen as immoral on such a holy day. Anyone who was seen celebrating was arrested! The ban was lifted in 1660.
- 12. An ancient legend states that forest animals can speak in human language on Christmas Eve!

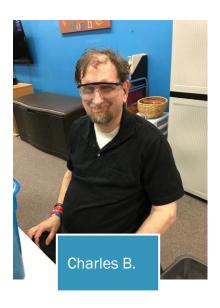
