What is an unwanted horse?

Based on a 2009 study by the American Veterinary Medical Association an unwanted horse is one that is no longer wanted by its owners. It may be a healthy horse that an owner can no longer afford to keep or feed. It may be a horse that is dangerous to handle and has injured (or is likely to injure) people. It may be a horse with an injury, lameness, or illness for which the owner is unwilling or unable to provide care. Some horses are no longer able to perform as their owner desires, such as racing, pleasure riding or something else. The fate of unwanted horses includes slaughter, abuse, neglect and starvation. The GAO estimated in 2012 that the number of unwanted horses in the United States *exceeded 170,000 animals*.




Fighting Chance Rescue 501c(3) rescued 37 horses after becoming a nonprofit rescue in 2016.



When a rescue comes to FCR we must provide the following kinds of care:

- Quarantine and hospital stall facilities
- Food and nutritional supplements
- Veterinary care for pest control, illness, wounds and immunizations
- Farrier services
- Halters, blankets and other supplies
- Exercise and rehabilitation

FCR is a nonprofit organization that provides these services to unwanted horses through public donations. We have made a large investment in our facilities to meet the needs of rescues, including adding a rescue barn, sand arena for exercise and separation turnouts. The Kinders also made a significant financial and labor donation to make overall improvements at the rescue farm. You can see the breakdown for FCR's expenses in this chart.
