WHAT WE DO

Showing in Hand

In hand showing involves showing the horse or pony in walk and trot whilst being led and gives you the opportunity to show the judge how well your horse or pony looks and moves

Ridden Showing

Ridden showing involves showing the judge you riding your horse or pony in walk, trot and canter (only walk and trot for lead rein). It gives you the opportunity to show the judge how well you can ride and your horse or pony's way of going forward

Handy Pony

Handy pony involves you riding your horse or pony round a short course of obstacles and gives you the opportunity to show the judge how well behaved your horse or pony is

Dressage

Dressage involves horse or pony and rider performing a set of predetermined movements known as 'figures' to show the judge how well you can perform set moves you have practised

Show Jumping

Show jumping involves riding your horse or pony over a course of fences or other obstacles in an arena with penalty points for errors. We have two show jumping rings; a main ring and also a novice ring where our younger or less experienced riders can also try show jumping

Novelty Classes

Novelty classes involve in hand showing in a fun and relaxed way and give you the opportunity to show the judge how well you handle him or her

Gymkhana

Gymkhana involves competitive games on horseback. Competitors are split into ages groups, Tiny Tots, Lead Rein, A group, B group, C group and Open. Gymkhana features five different games each show with competitors in each group racing against each other. Tiny tots features just three games



CLUB RULES FOR 2018

- Every member of the Club shall be polite and courteous to other members, committee members and judges.
- Members shall not mistreat in any way any horse or pony, whether inside or outside of the arena.
- No excess use of the whip, spurs, or using a bit as a means of punishment.
- No schooling whips shall be used within the jumping or fun arenas.
- Riders will pass left shoulder to left shoulder in the warm up arena.
 Riders will jump the practice fence in the warm up arena in accordance with the markings on the jump wings.
- No cantering or galloping outside of the arenas whilst on the show ground.
- Correct protective (correctly fitting and fastened) head-gear should be worn, in accordance with the British Riding Club (BRC) rules in all ridden classes.
- It is correct etiquette for the head to be covered in all in hand classes.
- All Junior leaders to wear a hard hat at all times.
- Shoulders should be covered. If it is a hot day the judge may allow members to ride without jackets, members must enter the arena wearing their jacket and politely ask permission of the judge to remove it.
- The judge's decision is final. All objections need to be in writing within seven days accompanied by a payment of £20.
- No interference from outside the arena which hinders judges or helpers from making decisions will be tolerated.
- Any member who uses foul or abusive language towards a judge or official will be issued with a warning. If bad behaviour continues the culprit will be banned from the next show.
- The Club, its Committee, or persons acting on their behalf shall not be held responsible for any accident or injuries to any persons or property howsoever caused.

- All members taking part in any event including Gymkhana and Handy Pony must wear Jodhpur boots or hard shoes. No plimsolls will be allowed. This rule also applies to anybody leading a pony in Gymkhana.
- A horse/pony many only take part in three jumping classes in any one show.
- A horse/pony may only take part in two gymkhana groups in any one show.
- Juniors are those who have not attained their 16th birthday by 1st
 January 2018. Seniors are those who are 16 or over on 1st January
 2018. The committee has the right to ask a member for proof of
 age.
- The Committee have the right to alter any schedule at their discretion.
- An animal that does not exceed 148cm (14.2hh) is not eligible to compete in a horse class. The Committee has the right to measure within a fortnight any horse/pony competing in a class where there is a height stipulated when an objection is made against the height of an animal which does not have a measurement certificate. Horse/ pony to be measured in a designated area with a witness present.
- The size, weight & experience of a rider must correspond to the size, build and experience of the pony. If the judge or Committee deems a rider to be overweight or unsafe, that rider will be eliminated from the competition. A rider is overweight for a pony if the rider's weight & saddle exceeds 20% of the pony's bodyweight.
- The judges/Committee reserve the right to decide if they believe that a horse and rider are not compatible as in size being appropriate & eliminate the competitor will be eliminated.
- A novice rider is when the combination have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the previous season and once a rider is placed 1st three times in the current season they are not allowed to enter the novice class again that season.
- A novice horse is one who has not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any class at any show in the previous season.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and owners must clear up after their dogs. Liability for damage caused by dogs rests with the owners.

- Owners and riders are responsible for their own ponies and horses and all horses or ponies must be under adequate control by a competent person at all times.
- All young stock must be handled by a competent person, all stallions must be handled by a person over 16 years of age.
- Any animal considered to be a danger to any person attending the show will not be allowed to remain on the showground and may be banned for the rest of the season.
- To win an end of year trophy, a member must have competed at a minimum of four shows during the year. End of year trophies will be awarded to the members who are the winner and runner-up in the points for each class






