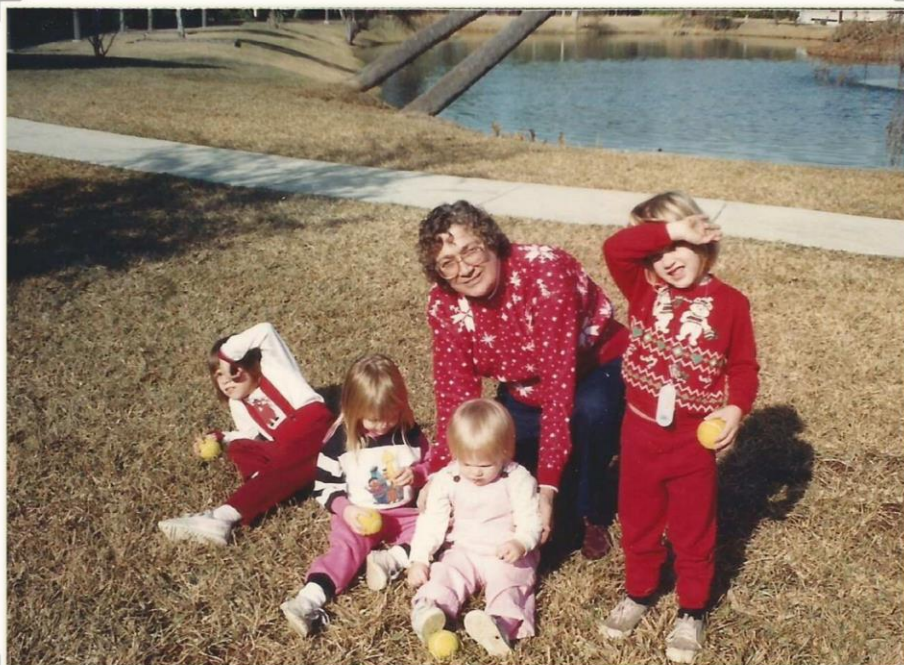


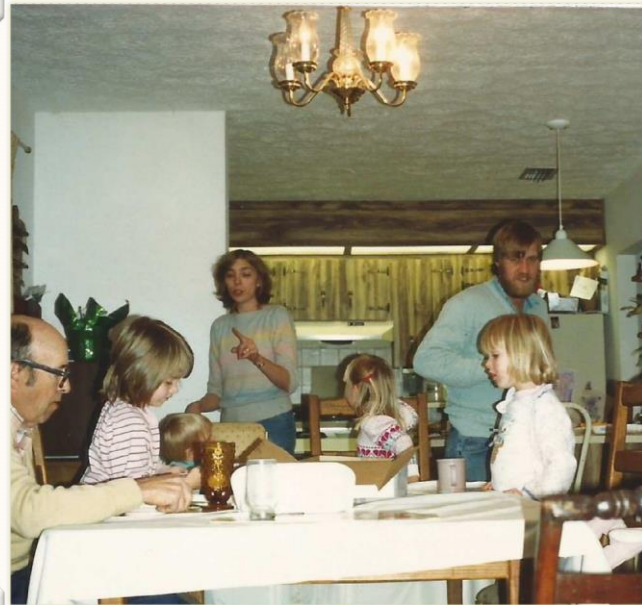


***1989 Stanley's birthday; Greg loved to led the group singing "Happy Birthday"-
Note - they are still living in the mobil home with three boys three & under!***



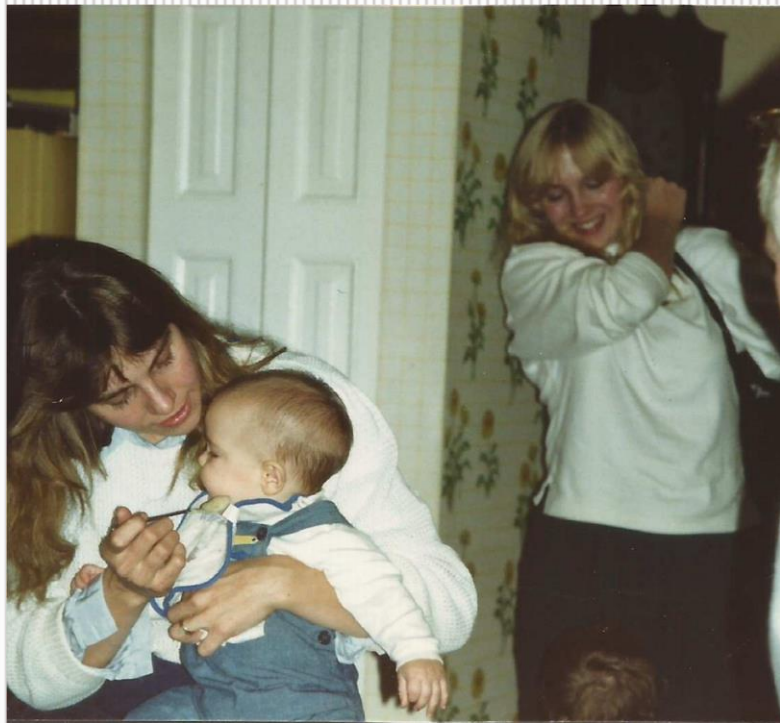

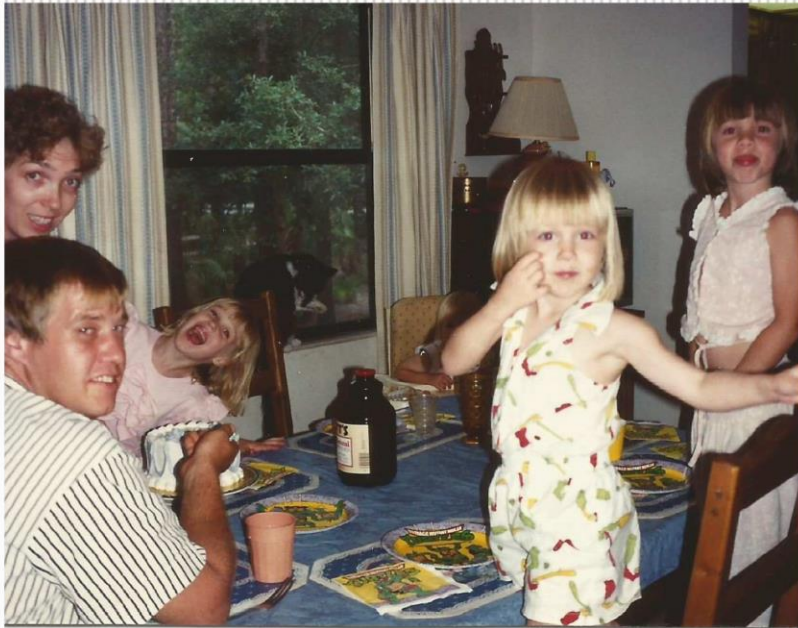

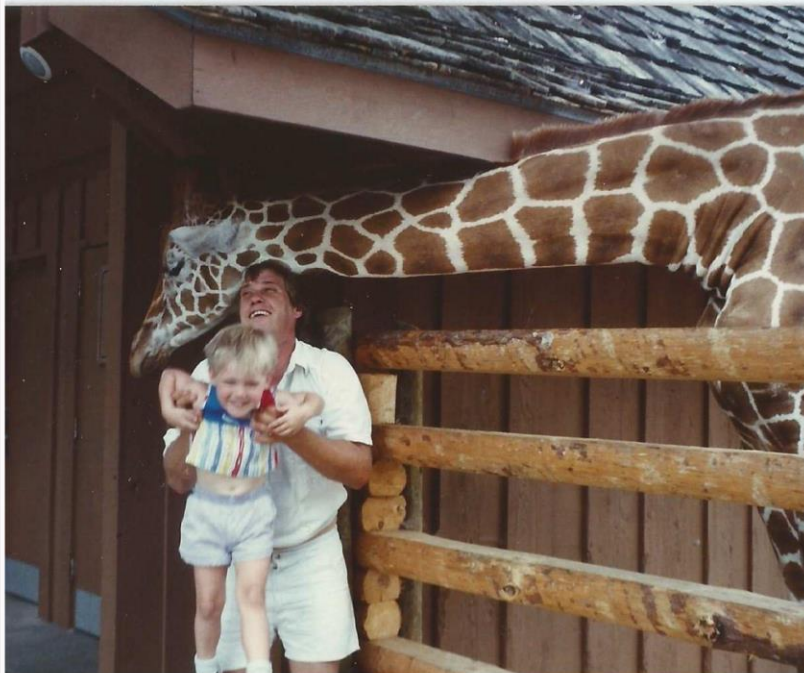


1990 May - Celebrate Amanda's birthday. This time I exchanged my time share for a place in Daytona Beach instead of New Smyrna Beach

Liz and the girls came north to celebrate Kerry's birthday. Of course that meant the Osmos visited me and we visited the Osmos





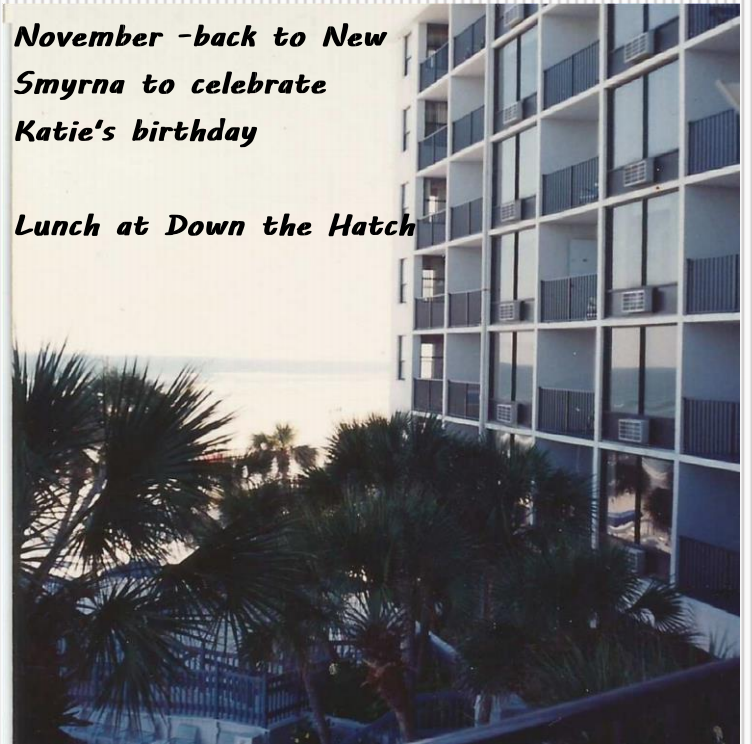

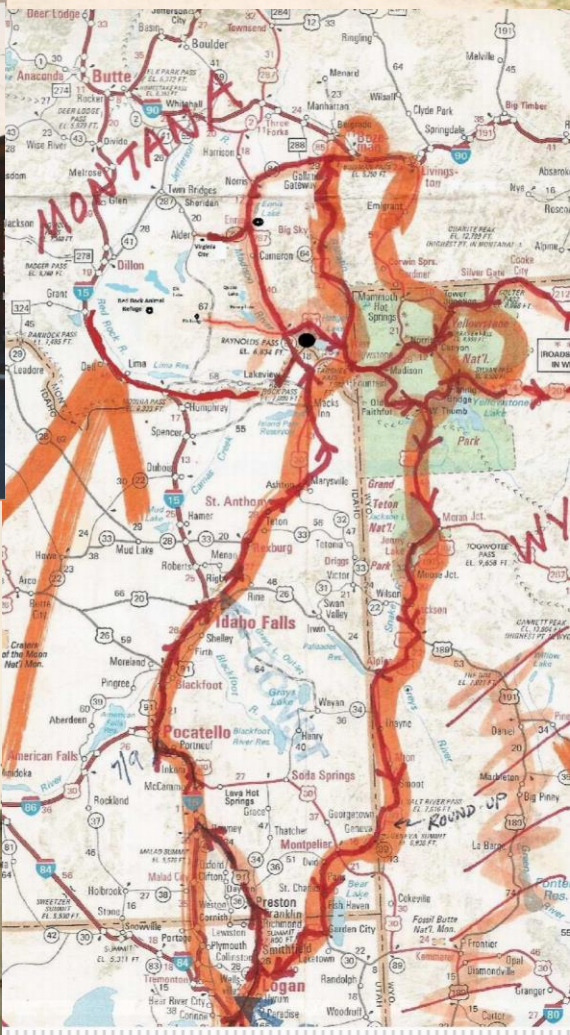

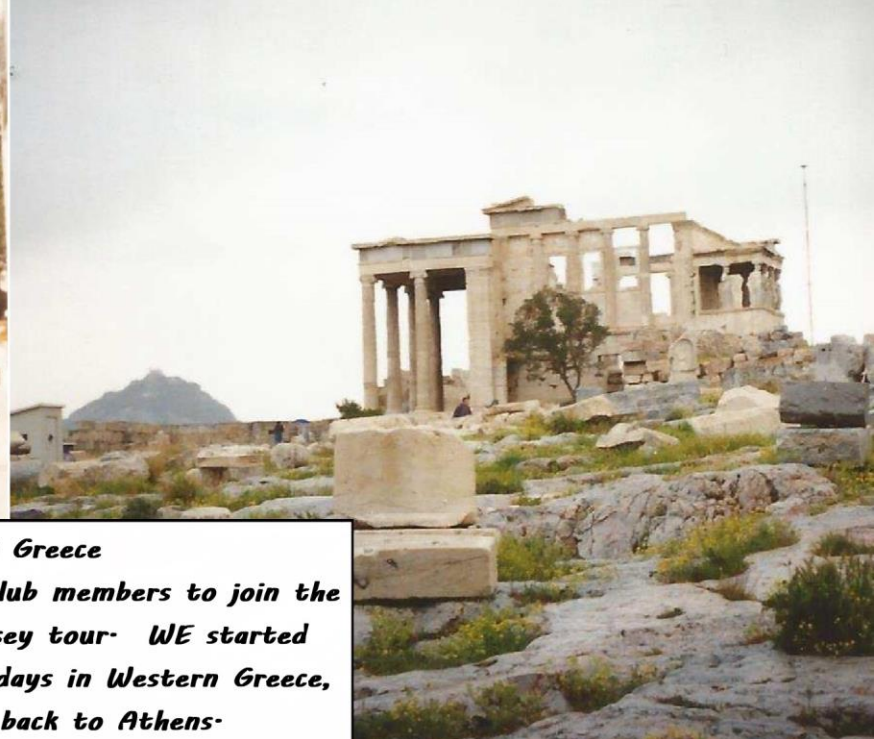

I bought Greene Pastures in 1993; settlement was the day before a sheriff sale- I spent the holidays in Perry County (at Osmos) and got snowed in- Central PA had record snows in 1994



Things had been going well with me by December 1993. I bought "Greene Pastures" in Markelsville, Perry County and the growing software staff had a new contract. TACJAM-A was awarded to AEL-Sanders. Bob Evans, the new VP of Engineering, seemed very supportive of the company's need to grow their software capabilities. He raved about a female software engineer from Litton; he convinced her to leave silicone valley and come east. Susan Hartenstine was to replace me as Manager of Software engineering and I would be a staff consultant- same pay, same office. Susan Hartenstine would start in January 1994.

There were no documents to write, no proposals to support, no programs to code. TACJAM-A program disappeared from my desk. Finally "Cell Jam" program came along. It was a design and development contract for a government drug enforcement agency. The system ran on a desk top PC with a serial interface to a receiver/transmitter. The software detected a cell phone call and identify the source number and destination number. The intent was to locate the calls and cause interference so the message would be misinterpreted. Just the source and destination would enable an agent to locate/identify a drug dealer and/or recipient.

In 1994 my schedule for the week

Monday morning. I would leave Markelsville about 9 o'clock and get to the office in time for lunch time bridge; leave work at five to enjoy a restful evening at home.

Tuesday was a typical work day except I would go to my weekly bridge club which met at seven.

Wednesday was 8-5 work day with lunch time bridge and TV at night.

Thursday was the same except I drove home, put Cece in her cat carrier and we headed for Markelsville.

Fridays consisted of projects around Greene Pastures. If it wasn't raining I was gardening; if it was raining it was a painting, scraping wallpaper, wall papering, refinishing woodwork or something.

On Saturdays and Sundays I was playing grandmother.



The Cell-Jam project was complete on time and within budget. While testing the system I spent hours playing "Free Cell" waiting for a cell phone call to be detected. The design engineer quit before he finished developing the transmitter. The program was terminated but not me.



The company was closed for the '94 Christmas holidays. I was in Markelsville most of December. Shelby was born November 30 and her christening was two weeks later. The holidays were spent with the family and my five grandchildren ranging in age from eight to one month. I was driving east on the turnpike on January 3, 1995 heading back to work when I decided no more! I would retire as a 60th birthday present to myself.



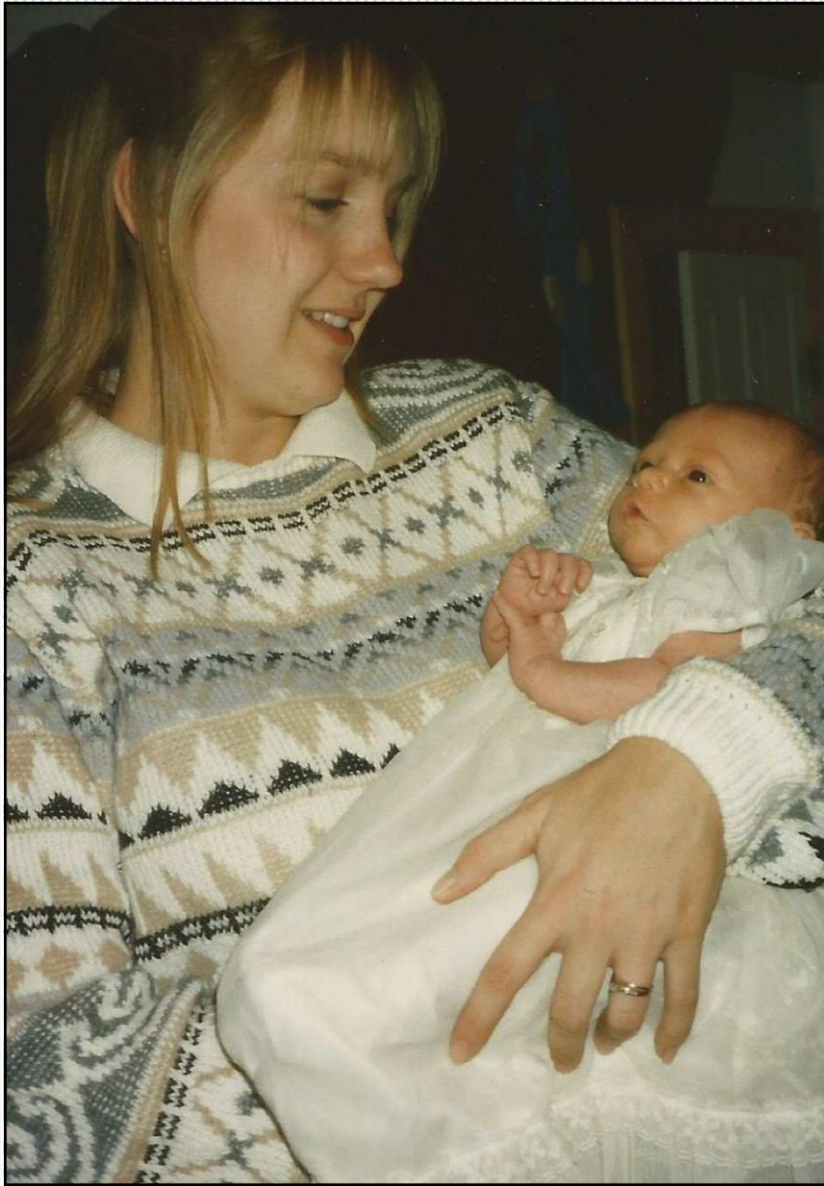
At this point I had already contacted Holly who had been my financial advisor for over twenty years. Holly studied my portfolio and convinced me there was enough money for me to retire if I lived in Perry County. As a result of the TACJAM-A award (also some negotiations for the company being sold) AEL's stock rose 275%. I exercised my stock options: bought large number of shares at \$4/share which I sold at \$14/share. Retirement looked more & more financially solvent!

That afternoon I marched into Susan's office and announced my retirement as of April 2, 1995, my sixtieth birthday.

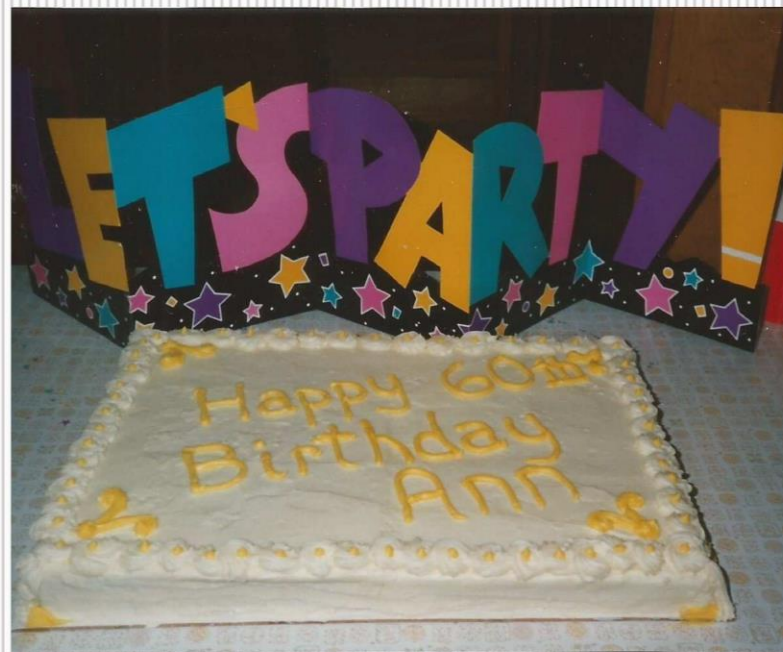

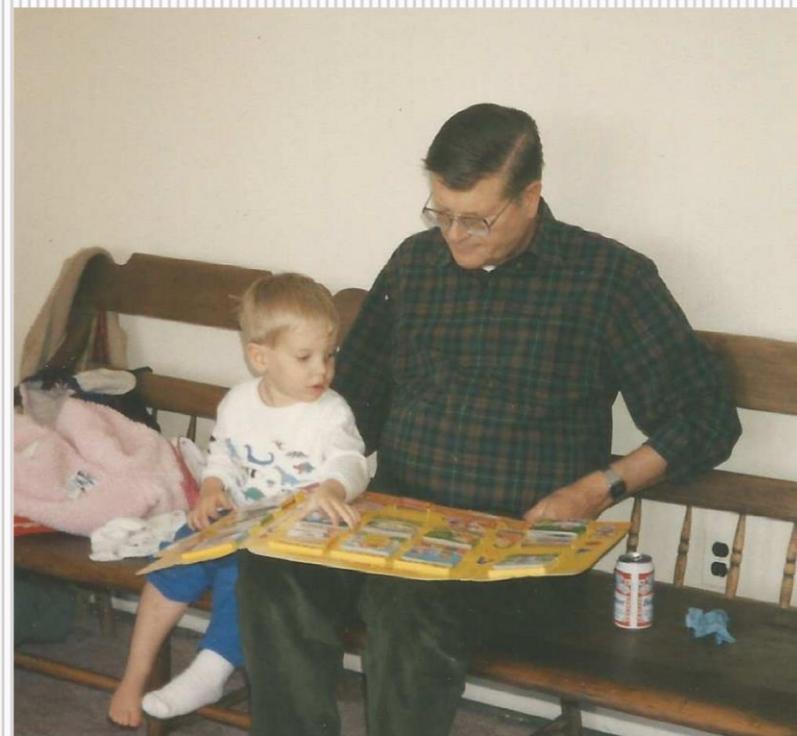




Shelby Ann Pio was born November 29, 1994.
