Dear Parents,

It is hard to believe that the summer term is here already!

Transition to school (for those children leaving us this summer)

We do hope you were allocated your chosen school. If you have any queries about your application please come and see me. Thank you for letting Emma in the office know which school your child will be attending, we will now be able to contact them to discuss transition. We want to ensure all children have a smooth transition into school and invite all schools to visit the children at Haven. The visiting staff are given time to meet your child and their key person. After half term Elaine will be taking small groups of children attending the same school to the library and give them time to get to know each other.

At the parent's evening in July you will be able to share your child's online learning journey with your key person. You will receive your own copy. Many schools are now using Tapestry and your child's learning journey will be sent to their school where their journey will continue into year R. If you have any worries about your child's transition into school please come and see your key person or myself.

Snack Money

We are finding it difficult to purchase snack/cooking food for the children as we are not receiving enough snack money. Just a reminder; that snack/fruit money this term is £1 per week or £6 for the half term. This money is essential for providing a wide range of ingredients for cooking (including forest school cooking) for the children and allows for many cookery ingredients to be paid for. We would be very grateful if you could send this in as we have not received many contributions and the cost of snack has increased considerably. Thank you for your support.

Sun cream

We are hoping the sun will be shining again soon and would be grateful if you could send a £2 donation towards sun cream and £2 towards bug repellent spray. We do prefer to use nursery sun cream as it is easier to manage! If your child has any allergies please send in your own cream/repellent.
