4th Grade Math: No Test this week.

We are learning about fractions and gaining an understanding what the parts of a fraction actually represent. A fraction has a numerator and denominator and your child needs to know these terms. We have been having fun talking about probability and the likely hood of something happening. We will be comparing fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and even working with mixed numbers in this chapter. Also, we will interpret circle graphs. *Please continue working at home with your child on their basic math facts for addition, subtraction, multiplication & division.

5th Grade Math: Test Monday, October 22nd over Multiplication.

Tuesday we will begin our chapter over Geometry—Lines & Angles. In this chapter we will be learning a lot of geometric terms so it is extremely important that your child is studying these terms at home. We will learn about points, lines, planes, rays, angles, triangles, circles & graphing figures. Also, please have your child work on math facts at home.

6th Grade Math: No Test this week.

We are starting a new chapter on fractions. We will work intensely with greatest common factors, least common multiples, proper and improper fractions, adding, subtracting, comparing, finding equivalent fractions, & finding percents. Your child is working hard in class and is finding out how important following directions is with this book. The littlest of details is so important!

7th & 8th Grade Math: No Test this week.

Chapter 3 covers basic linear equations and inequalities. Students will solve then graph the inequalities on a number line. We will solve real life word problems and apply our knowledge and the concepts learned in previous chapters. Has your child learned the important rules from chapter 1 and 2? This is the key to their success.
